

The Last War & the Judgment

Rev 20:7-8

And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

Rev 20:8

And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.

Eze 38:2-3

Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him,

Eze 38:3

And say, Thus saith the Lord Ahayah; Behold, I *am* against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:

Eaze 39:2

And I will turn thee back, and leave but the sixth part of thee, and will cause thee to come up from the north parts, and will bring thee upon the mountains of Israel:

Eze 38:4-16

And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts *of armour, even* a great company *with* bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:

Eze 38:5

Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them; all of them with shield and helmet:

Eze 38:6

Gomer, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his bands: *and* many people with thee.

Eze 38:7

Be thou prepared, and prepare for thyself, thou, and all thy company that are assembled unto thee, and be thou a guard unto them.

Eze 38:8

After many days thou shalt be visited: in the latter years thou shalt come into the land *that is* brought back from the sword, *and is* gathered out of many people, against the mountains of Israel, which have been always waste: but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

Eze 38:9



Thou shalt ascend and come like a storm, thou shalt be like a cloud to cover the land, thou, and all thy bands, and many people with thee.

Eze 38:10

Thus saith the Lord Ahayah; It shall also come to pass, *that* at the same time shall things come into thy mind, and thou shalt think an evil thought:

Eze 38:11

And thou shalt say, I will go up to the land of unwalled villages; I will go to them that are at rest, that dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates,

Eze 38:12

To take a spoil, and to take a prey; to turn thine hand upon the desolate places *that are now* inhabited, and upon the people *that are* gathered out of the nations, which have gotten cattle and goods, that dwell in the midst of the land.

Eze 38:13

Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

Eze 38:14

Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say unto Gog, Thus saith the Lord Ahayah; In that day when my people of Israel dwelleth safely, shalt thou not know *it?*

Eze 38:15

And thou shalt come from thy place out of the north parts, thou, and many people with thee, all of them riding upon horses, a great company, and a mighty army:

Eze 38:16

And thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; it shall be in the latter days, and I will bring thee against my land, that the heathen may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes.

Eze 38:18-23

And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord Ahayah, *that* my fury shall come up in my face.

Eze 38:19

For in my jealousy *and* in the fire of my wrath have I spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel;

Eze 38:20

So that the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep upon the earth, and all the men that *are* upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.



Eze 38:21

And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord Ahayah: every man's sword shall be against his brother.

Eze 38:22

And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that *are* with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone.

Eze 38:23

Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Eze 39:4-5

Thou shalt fall upon the mountains of Israel, thou, and all thy bands, and the people that *is* with thee: I will give thee unto the ravenous birds of every sort, and *to* the beasts of the field to be devoured.

Eze 39:5

Thou shalt fall upon the open field: for I have spoken it, saith the Lord AHAYAH.

Eze 39:17-20

And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord AHAYAH; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, *even* a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.

Eze 39:18

Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.

Eze 39:19

And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

Eze 39:20

Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord AHAYAH.

Eze 39:6

And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that I *am* the LORD.

Rev 20:9 -10

And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from Alahayim out of heaven, and devoured them.

Eze 39:7



So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not *let them* pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that I *am* the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.

Eze 39:21-24

And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them.

Eze 39:22

So the house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their Alahayim from that day and forward.

Eze 39:23

And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they trespassed against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword.

Eze 39:24

According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them.

Eze 39:8 -24

Behold, it is come, and it is done, saith the Lord Ahayah; this is the day whereof I have spoken.

Eze 39:9 And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:

Eze 39:10

So that they shall take no wood out of the field, neither cut down *any* out of the forests; for they shall burn the weapons with fire: and they shall spoil those that spoiled them, and rob those that robbed them, saith the Lord AHAYAH.

Eze 39:11

And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* I will give unto Gog a place there of graves in Israel, the valley of the passengers on the east of the sea: and it shall stop the *noses* of the passengers: and there shall they bury Gog and all his multitude: and they shall call *it* The valley of Hamongog.

Eze 39:12

And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land.

Eze 39:13

Yea, all the people of the land shall bury *them*; and it shall be to them a renown the day that I shall be glorified, saith the Lord AHAYAH.

Eze 39:14



And they shall sever out men of continual employment, passing through the land to bury with the passengers those that remain upon the face of the earth, to cleanse it: after the end of seven months shall they search.

Eze 39:15

And the passengers *that* pass through the land, when *any* seeth a man's bone, then shall he set up a sign by it, till the buriers have buried it in the valley of Hamongog.

Eze 39:16

And also the name of the city *shall be* Hamonah. Thus shall they cleanse the land.

Rev 20:10

And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

2Es 7:30

And the world shall be turned into the old silence seven days, like as in the former judgments: so that no man shall remain.

2Es 7:32

And the earth shall restore those that are asleep in her, and so shall the dust those that dwell in silence, and the secret places shall deliver those souls that were committed unto them.

Apocalypse of Peter Chapter 4

Behold now what shall come upon them in the last days, when the day of Alahayim and the day of the decision of the judgement of Alahayim cometh. From the east unto the west shall all the children of men be gathered together before my Father that liveth for ever. And he shall command hell to open its bars of adamant and give up all that is therein. And the wild beasts and the fowls shall he command to restore all the flesh that they have devoured, because he willeth that men should appear; for nothing perisheth before Alahayim, and nothing is impossible with him, because all things are his.

For all things come to pass on the day of decision, on the day of judgement, at the word of Alahayim: and as all things were done when he created the world and commanded all that is therein and it was done -even so shall it be in the last days;

for all things are possible with Alahayim. And therefore saith he in the scripture: Son of man, prophesy upon the several bones and say unto the bones: bone unto bone in joints, sinew, nerves, flesh and skin and hair thereon [and soul and spirit]. And soul and spirit shall the great Uriel give them at the commandment of Alahayim; for him hath Alahayim set over the rising again of the dead at the day of judgement.



2 Baruch 50:2-3

2 For the earth shall then assuredly restore the dead, [Which it now receives, in order to preserve them].

It shall make no change in their form, But as it has received, so shall it restore them, And as I delivered them unto it, so also shall it raise them.

3 For then it will be necessary to show the living that the dead have come to life again, and that those who had departed have returned (again).

2 Baruch 50:4

4 And it shall come to pass, when they have severally recognized those whom they now know, then judgment shall grow strong, and those things which before were spoken of shall come.

Apocalypse of Peter chapter 5

.....Behold and consider the corns of wheat that are sown in the earth. As things dry and without soul do men sow them in the earth: and they live again and bear fruit, and the earth restoreth them as a pledge entrusted unto it. [And this that dieth, that is sown as seed in the earth, and shall become alive and be restored unto life, is man. How much more shall Alahayim raise up on the day of decision them that believe in him and are chosen of him, for whose sake he made the world? And all things shall the earth restore on the day of decision, for it also shall be judged with them, and the heaven with it.

Ascension of Isaiah 4:18

18. Then the voice of the Beloved will reprove in anger this heaven and this earth, and the mountains and the hills and the cities and the desert and the trees and the angel of the sun and that of the moon, and everywhere Beliar has appeared and acted openly in this world. There will be a resurrection and a judgment in their midst in those days, and the Beloved will cause fire to rise from Him, and it will consume all the impious, and they will be as if they had not been created.

2Pe 3:7

But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of unalahayimly men.

Apocalypse of Peter Chapter 5

And this shall come at the day of judgement upon them that have fallen away from faith in Alahayim and that have committed sin: Floods (cataracts) of fire shall be let loose; and darkness and obscurity shall come up and clothe and veil the whole world and the waters shall be changed and turned into coals of fire and all that is in them shall burn, and the sea shall become fire. Under the heaven shall be a sharp fire that cannot be quenched and floweth to fulfil the judgement of wrath. And the stars shall fly in pieces



by flames of fire, as if they had not been created and the powers (firmaments) of the heaven shall pass away for lack of water and shall be as though they had not been. And the lightnings of heaven shall be no more, and by their enchantment they shall affright the world. The heaven shall turn to lightning and the lightnings thereof shall affright the world. The spirits of the dead bodies shall be like them and shall become fire at the commandment of Alahayim. And as soon as the whole creation dissolveth, the men that are in the east shall flee unto the west, unto the east; they that are in the south shall flee to the north, and those who are in the north to the south. And in all places shall the wrath of a fearful fire overtake them and an unquenchable flame driving them shall bring them unto the judgement of wrath, unto the stream of unquenchable fire that floweth, flaming with fire, and when the waves thereof part themselves one from another, burning, there shall be a great gnashing of teeth among the children of men. Chapter 6

Then shall they all behold me coming upon an eternal cloud of brightness: and the angels of Alahayim that are with me shall sit upon the throne of my glory at the right hand of my Heavenly Father; and he shall set a crown upon mine head. And when the nations behold it, they shall weep, every nation for itself.

Rev 20:11

And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

II Ezra 7:33-44

33 The Most High shall be revealed on the seat of judgment, and compassion shall pass away, and patience shall be withdrawn.

II Ezra 7:34

34 Only judgment shall remain, truth shall stand, and faithfulness shall grow strong. II Ezra 7:35

35 Recompense shall follow, and the reward shall be manifested; righteous deeds shall awake, and unrighteous deeds shall not sleep.

II Ezra 7:36

The pit of torment shall appear, and opposite it shall be the place of rest; and the furnace of hell shall be disclosed, and opposite it the paradise of delight.

II Ezra 7:37

Then the Most High will say to the nations that have been raised from the dead, 'Look now, and understand whom you have denied, whom you have not served, whose commandments you have despised.

II Ezra 7:38

Look on this side and on that; here are delight and rest, and there are fire and torments.' Thus he will speak to them on the day of judgment—

II Ezra 7:39



a day that has no sun or moon or stars,

II Ezra 7:40

or cloud or thunder or lightning, or wind or water or air, or darkness or evening or morning,

II Ezra 7:41

or summer or spring or heat or winter or frost or cold, or hail or rain or dew,

II Ezra 7:42

or noon or night, or dawn or shining or brightness or light, but only the splendor of the glory of the Most High, by which all shall see what has been destined.

II Ezra 7:43

It will last as though for a week of years.

II Ezra 7:44

This is my judgment and its prescribed order; and to you alone I have shown these things."

Rev 20:12-13

And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Alahayim; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. Rev 20:13

And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Apocalypse of Peter chapter 6 continued

......Then shall he command them to enter into the river of fire while the works of every one of them shall stand before them. Rewards shall be given to every man according to his deeds. As for the elect that have done good, they shall come unto me and not see death by the devouring fire. But the unrighteous the sinners, and the hypocrites shall stand in the depths of darkness that shall not pass away, and their chastisement is the fire, and angels bring forward their sins and prepare for them a place wherein they shall be punished for ever (everyone according to his transgression).

Apocalypse of Peter 3

Chapter 3

And he showed me in his right hand the souls of all men, And on the palm of his right hand the image of that which shall be accomplished at the last day: and how the righteous and the sinners shall be separated, and how those who are upright in heart shall fare, and how the evil-doers shall be rooted out to all eternity. We beheld how the sinners wept (weep) in great affliction and sorrow, until all that saw it with their eyes wept, whether righteous or angels, and he himself also



Apocalypse of Peter Chapter 13

Thereafter shall the angels bring mine elect and righteous which are perfect in all uprightness, and bear them in their hands, and clothe them with the raiment of the life that is above. They shall see their desire on them that hated them, when he punisheth them, and the torment of every one shall be for ever according to his works. And all they that are in torment shall say with one voice: have mercy upon us, for now know we the judgement of Alahayim, which he declared unto us aforetime, and we believed not. And the angel Tatirokos (Tartaruchus, keeper of hell) shall come and chastise them with yet greater torment, and say unto them: Now do ye repent, when it is no longer the time for repentance, and nought of life remaineth. And they shall say: Righteous is the judgement of Alahayim, for we have heard and perceived that his judgement is good; for we are recompensed according to our deeds.

Chapter 14

Then will I give unto mine elect and righteous the washing (baptism) and the salvation for which they have besought me, in the field of Akrosja (Acherousia), which is called Aneslasleja (Elysium). They shall adorn with flowers the portion of the righteous, and I shall go ... I shall rejoice with them. <u>I will cause the peoples to enter in to mine everlasting kingdom</u>, and show them that eternal thing (life?) whereon I have made them to set their hope, even I and my Father which is in heaven.

2Es 7:31

And after seven days the world, that yet awaketh not, shall be raised up, and that shall die that is corrupt

1Co 15:50-54

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of Alahayim; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

1Co 15:51

Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 1Co 15:52

In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1Co 15:53

For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.

1Co 15:54

So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.



Rev 20:14

And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev 20:15

And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

II Ezra 7:45-47

I answered and said, "O Lord AHAYAH, I said then and I say now:

Blessed are those who are alive and keep your commandments!

II Ezra 7:46

But what of those for whom I prayed? For who among the living is there that has not sinned, or who is there among mortals that has not transgressed your covenant?

II Ezra 7:47

And now I see that the world to come will bring delight to few, but torments to many.
