

# Understanding Unlawful Images

Num 33:52

Then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their <u>pictures</u>, <u>H4906</u> and destroy all their molten images, and quite pluck down all their high places

Definition:

Image H6754

From an unused root meaning to shade; a phantom, that is, (figuratively) illusion, resemblance; hence a representative figure, especially an idol: - image, vain shew.

Toys

Jasher 61:8-10

8. And amongst the servants of Angeas was a youth of fifteen years old, Balaam son of Beor was his name, and the youth was very wise and understood the art of witchcraft. 9. And Angeas said unto Balaam, conjure for us, I pray thee, with the witchcraft, that we may know who will prevail in this battle to which we are now proceeding. 10. 1 Maccabees 3:48

And laid open the book of the law, wherein the heathen had sought to paint the likeness of their images.

1 Maccabees 3:50

Then cried they with a loud voice toward heaven, saying, What shall we do with these, and whither shall we carry them away?

Luke 20:24

Shew me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

Luke 20:25

And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto Alahayim the things which be Alahayim's.

Jasher 80:45

45. Also the likenesses of the firstborn of Egypt that were carved in the walls of their houses, were destroyed and fell to the ground

Exodus 12:12

For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the alahayims of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am Ahayah.

Lev 18:2

Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, I am Ahayah your Alahayim.

Deu 7:25

The graven images of their alahayim shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for it is an abomination to Ahayah thy Alahayim.

Deu 7:26

Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: but thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing.

Joshua 7:20
