John 7:37

In the last day, that great day of the feast, Yache stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

Hermas parable 9 (15:1-2)

15[92]:1 "Declare to me, Sir," say I, "the names of the virgins, and of the women that are clothed in the black garments." "Hear," saith he, "the names of the more powerful virgins, those that are stationed at the corners.

15[92]:2 The first is Faith, and the second, Continence, and the third, Power, and the fourth, Long-suffering. But the others stationed between them have these names-Simplicity, Guilelessness, Purity, Cheerfulness, Truth, Understanding, Concord, Love. He that beareth these names and the name of the Son of Alahayim shall be able to enter into the kingdom of Alahayim.

Wisdom of Solomon 7:26

For she is the brightness of the everlasting light, the unspotted mirror of the power of Alahayim, and the image of his goodness.

Sir 36:23

If there be kindness, meekness, and comfort, in her tongue, then is not her husband like other men

The word of Alahayim most high is the fountain of wisdom; and her ways are everlasting commandments.

Ecclesiasticus 1:14

To fear the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and it was created with the faithful in the womb.

Ecclesiasticus 1:15

She hath built an everlasting foundation with men, and she shall continue with their seed.

Ecclesiasticus 1:16

To fear the Lord is fulness of wisdom, and filleth men with her fruits.

Ecclesiasticus 1:17

She filleth all their house with things desirable, and the garners with her increase.

Wisdom of Solomon 7:27

And being but one, she can do all things: and remaining in herself, she maketh all things new: and in all ages entering into holy souls, she maketh them friends of Alahayim, and prophets.

John 15:14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.

Wisdom of Solomon 7:28

For Alahayim loveth none but him that dwelleth with wisdom.

Ecclesiasticus 1:16

To fear the Lord is fulness of wisdom, and filleth men with her fruits.

Ecclesiasticus 1:17

She filleth all their house with things desirable, and the garners with her increase.

Ecclesiasticus 1:18

The fear of the Lord is a crown of wisdom, making peace and perfect health to flourish; both which are the gifts of Alahayim: and it enlargeth their rejoicing that love him.

Ecclesiasticus 1:19

Wisdom raineth down skill and knowledge of understanding standing, and exalteth them to honour that hold her fast.

Ecclesiasticus 1:20

The root of wisdom is to fear the Lord, and the branches thereof are long life.



Ecclesiasticus 1:21

The fear of the Lord driveth away sins: and where it is present, it turneth away wrath.

Ecclesiasticus 1:26

If thou desire wisdom, keep the commandments, and the Lord shall give her unto thee.

Ecclesiasticus 1:28

Distrust not the fear of the Lord when thou art poor: and come not unto him with a double heart.

Ecclesiasticus 1:29

Be not an hypocrite in the sight of men, and take good heed what thou speakest.

Ecclesiasticus 1:30

Exalt not thyself, lest thou fall, and bring dishonour upon thy soul, and so Alahayim discover thy secrets, and cast thee down in the midst of the congregation, because thou camest not in truth to the fear of the Lord, but thy heart is full of deceit.

Ecclesiasticus 1:27

For the fear of the Lord is wisdom and instruction: and faith and meekness are his delight.

Wisdom of Solomon 6:17

For the very true beginning of her is the desire of discipline; and the care of discipline is love;

Wisdom of Solomon 6:18

And love is the keeping of her laws; and the giving heed unto her laws is the assurance of incorruption;

Wisdom of Solomon 6:19

And incorruption maketh us near unto Alahayim:

Wisdom of Solomon 6:20

Therefore the desire of wisdom bringeth to a kingdom.
