## **Isa 13:1**

The burden of Babylon, which Isaiah the son of Amoz did see.

## **Isa 13:4**

The noise of a multitude in the mountains, like as of a great people; a tumultuous noise of the kingdoms of nations gathered together: Ahayah of hosts mustereth the host of the battle

## **Jer 50:25**

The LORD hath opened his armoury, and hath brought forth the weapons of his indignation: for this is the work of the Lord Ahayah of hosts in the land of the Chaldeans.

## **Jer 50:3**

For out of the north there cometh up a nation against her, which shall make her land desolate, and none shall dwell therein: they shall remove, they shall depart, both man and beast.

## **Rev 18:8**

Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord Alahayim who judgeth her

## **Rev 17:16**

And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.

## **Rev 17:17**

For Alahayim hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of Alahayim shall be fulfilled.

## **Jer 50:3**

For out of the north there cometh up a nation against her, which shall make her land desolate, and none shall dwell therein: they shall remove, they shall depart, both man and beast.


## **Jer 50:16**

Cut off the sower from Babylon, and him that handleth the sickle in the time of harvest: .....for fear of the oppressing sword they shall turn every one to his people, and they shall flee every one to his own land

## **Isa 13:17**

Behold, I will stir up the Medes against them, which shall not regard silver; and as for gold, they shall not delight in it.

## **Isa 13:18**



Their bows also shall dash the young men to pieces; and they shall have no pity on the fruit of the womb; their eye shall not spare children.

**Isa 13:14**

And it shall be as the chased roe, and as a sheep that no man taketh up: they shall every man turn to his own people, and flee every one into his own land

**Isa 13:15**

Every one that is found shall be thrust through; and every one that is joined *unto them* shall fall by the sword.

**Isa 13:16**

Their children also shall be dashed to pieces before their eyes; their houses shall be spoiled, and their wives ravished.

**Jer 51:9**

We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her judgment reacheth unto heaven, and is lifted up even to the skies

**Jer 51:50**

Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not still: remember Ahayah afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind.

**Jer 50:8**

Remove out of the midst of Babylon, and go forth out of the land of the Chaldeans, and be as the he goats before the flocks.

**Jer 50:9**

For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows *shall be* as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain.

**Jer 50:10**

And Chaldea shall be a spoil: all that spoil her shall be satisfied, saith the LORD.

**Jer 51:50**


Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not still: remember Ahayah afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind.

**Jer 50:28**

The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of Ahayah our Alahayim, the vengeance of his temple.

**Jer 50:29**

Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her: for she hath been proud against the LORD, against the Holy One of Israel.



**Jer 50:30**

Therefore shall her young men fall in the streets, and all her men of war shall be cut off in that day, saith the LORD.

**Jer 50:13** Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: every one that goeth by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues.

**Jer 50:4**

In those days, and in that time, saith Ahayah, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek Ahayah their Alahayim.

**Jer 50:5**

They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, *saying*, Come, and let us join ourselves to Ahayah in a perpetual covenant *that* shall not be forgotten

2baruch 28:1-3,7

28 1 Nevertheless, whoever understands shall then be wise. 2 For the measure and reckoning of that time are two parts a week of seven weeks.' 3 And I answered and said: 'It is good for a man to come and behold, but it is better that he should not come lest he fall

7 Is it in one place or in one of the parts of the earth that those things are come to pass, or will the whole earth experience (them) ?

II Baruch 29:1

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.


Psalms 91:2
