Understanding the Household

1 Clem. 33:5

For thus saith Alahayim Let us make man after our image and after our likeness. And Alahayim made man; male and female made He them.

2 Clem. 14:2

And I do not suppose ye are ignorant that the living Church is the body of Christ: for the scripture saith, Alahayim made man, male and female. The male is Christ and the female is the Church.

Ecclesiasticus 36:24

He that getteth a wife beginneth a possession, a help like unto himself, and a pillar of rest.

Ephesians 5:23

For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Ephesians 5:24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing.

Ecclesiasticus 25:1

In three things I was beautified, and stood up beautiful both before Alahayim and men: the unity of brethren, the love of neighbours, a man and a wife that agree together.

Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

Ephesians 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.



Ephesians 5:28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

Philippians 1:9

And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment;

Philippians 1:10 That ye may approve things that are excellent;

Romans 2:18

And knowest his will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law;

Phil 1:10

...that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

Philippians 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Yache Christ, unto the glory and praise of Alahayim .

Baruch 3:35

This is our Alahayim, and there shall none other be accounted of in comparison of him
Baruch 3:36 He hath found out all the way of knowledge, and hath given it unto Jacob his servant, and to Israel his beloved.

Baruch 3:37 Afterward did he shew himself upon earth, and conversed with men.

Ecclesiasticus 45:1

And he brought out of him a merciful man, which found favour in the sight of all flesh, even Moses, beloved of Alahayim and men, whose memorial is blessed.

Ecclesiasticus 45:5 He made him to hear his voice, and brought him into the dark cloud, and gave him commandments before his face, even the law of life and knowledge, that he might teach Jacob his covenants, and Israel his judgments.

Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.

Psalms 37:8

Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.

Hebrews 12:14

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Hebrews 12:15 Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of Alahayim; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;

Ephesians 5:31

1 Peter 3:6 Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.

For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.

John 12:50 And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

1 Timothy 4:2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

2 Timothy 3:1

This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

2 Timothy 3:2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves,

covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

2 Timothy 3:3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

2 Timothy 3:4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of Alahayim;

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of holiness, but denying the power thereof:

2 Timothy 3:6 For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

2 Timothy 3:7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Isaiah 3:12

As for my people, children are their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause thee to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.



Jeremiah 23:1

Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith Ahayah.

Jeremiah 23:2 Therefore thus saith Ahayah Alahayim of Israel against the pastors that feed my people; Ye have scattered my flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith Ahayah.

Jeremiah 23:13

And I have seen folly in the prophets of Samaria; they prophesied in Baal, and caused my people Israel to err.

Hermas Mandate 11

...He that sitteth on the chair is a false prophet who destroyeth the mind of the servants of Alahayim--I mean, of the doubtful-minded, not of the faithful.

1[43]:2 These doubtful-minded ones then come to him as to a soothsayer and enquire of him what shall befall them. And he, the false prophet, having no power of a divine Spirit in himself, speaketh with them according to their enquiries [and according to the lusts of their wickedness], and filleth their souls as they themselves wish.

1[43]:3 For being empty himself he giveth empty answers to empty enquirers; for whatever enquiry may be made of him, he answereth according to the emptiness of the man. But he speaketh also some true words; for the devil filleth him with his own spirit, if so be he shall be able to break down some of the righteous.

1[43]:4 So many therefore as are strong in the faith of the Lord, clothed with the truth, cleave not to such spirits, but hold aloof from them; but as many as are doubters and frequently change their minds, practice soothsaying like the Gentiles, and bring upon themselves greater sin by their idolatries. For he that consulteth a false prophet on any matter is an idolater and emptied of the truth, and senseless.

Jeremiah 23:14

I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah.



Psalms of Solomon 4

1. Wherefore sittest thou, O profane man, in the council of the pious, Seeing that thy heart is far removed from Ahayah, Provoking with transgressions the Alahayim of Israel?
2. Extravagant in speech, extravagant in outward seeming beyond all men, Is he that is severe of speech in condemning sinners in judgement.
3. And his hand is first upon him as though he acted in zeal, And yet he is himself guilty in respect of manifold sins and of wantonness.
4. His eyes are upon every woman without distinction; His tongue lieth when he maketh contract with an oath.
5. By night and in secret he sinneth as though unseen, With his eyes he talketh to every woman of evil compacts.
6. He is swift to enter every house with cheerfulness as though guileless.
7. Let Alahayim remove those that live in hypocrisy in the company of the pious, Even the life of such an one with corruption of his flesh and penury.
8. Let Alahayim reveal the deeds of the men-pleasers, The deeds of such an one with laughter and derision;
9. That the pious may count righteous the judgement of their Alahayim, When sinners are removed from before the righteous,
10. Even the man-pleaser who uttereth law guilefully.
11. And their eyes are fixed upon any man's house that is still secure, That they may, like the Serpent, destroy the wisdom of . . . with words of transgressors,
12. His words are deceitful that he may accomplish his wicked desire.
13. He never ceaseth from scattering families as though they were orphans, Yea, he layeth waste a house on account of his lawless desire.
14. He deceiveth with words, saying, There is none that seeth, or judgeth.
15. He fills one house with lawlessness, And then his eyes are fixed upon the next house, To destroy it with words that give wing to desire. Yet with all these his soul like Sheol, is not sated.

Jeremiah 23:16

Thus saith Ahayah of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of Ahayah.

Jeremiah 23:17 They say still unto them that despise me, Ahayah hath said, Ye shall have peace;

and they say unto every one that walketh after the imagination of his own heart, No evil shall come upon you.



Jeremiah 23:18

For who hath stood in the counsel of Ahayah, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard it?

Jeremiah 23:21

I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied.

Jeremiah 23:22 But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

Ecclesiasticus 15:14

He himself made man from the beginning, and left him in the hand of his counsel;

Ecclesiasticus 15:15 If thou wilt, to keep the commandments, and to perform acceptable faithfulness.

Gad the seer 8:7

7.And He gave each one free choice: if one wants to do good, he will be helped, and if one wants to do evil, a path will be opened for him.

Ecclesiasticus 15:16 He hath set fire and water before thee: stretch forth thy hand unto whether thou wilt.

Ecclesiasticus 15:17 Before man is life and death; and whether him liketh shall be given him.

Luk 16:15

And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but Alahayim knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of Alahayim

2Es 7:20

For there be many that perish in this life, because they despise the law of Alahayim that is set before them.

2Es 7:21 For Alahayim hath given strait commandment to such as came, what they should do to live, even as they came, and what they should observe to avoid punishment.

2Es 7:22 Nevertheless they were not obedient unto him; but spake against him, and imagined vain things;



2Es 7:23 And deceived themselves by their wicked deeds; and said of the most High, that he is not; and knew not his ways:

2Es 7:24 But his law have they despised, and denied his covenants; in his statutes have they not been faithful, and have not performed his works.

2Es 8:56

For when they had taken liberty,

For when they had taken liberty, they despised the most High, thought scorn of his law, and forsook his ways

2Es 9:9

Then shall they be in pitiful case, which now have abused my ways: and they that have cast them away despitefully shall dwell in torments.

2Es 9:10 For such as in their life have received benefits, and have not known me;

2Es 9:11 And they that have loathed my law, while they had yet liberty, and, when as yet place of repentance was open unto them, understood not, but despised it;

2Es 9:12 The same must know it after death by pain.



The Deliverance of the Household

Ezekiel 34:6

My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered upon all the face of the earth, and none did search or seek after them.

Ezekiel 34:11 For thus saith the Lord Ahayah; Behold, I, even I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out.

Ezekiel 34:12 As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

Isa 30:20

And *though* the Lord give you the bread of adversity, and the water of affliction, yet shall not thy teachers be removed into a corner any more, but thine eyes shall see thy teachers:

Isa 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Sir 4:13 He that holdeth her fast shall inherit glory; and wheresoever she entereth, the Lord will bless.

Sir 4:14 They that serve her shall minister to the Holy One: and them that love her the Lord doth love.

Sir 4:15 Whoso giveth ear unto her shall judge the nations: and he that attendeth unto her shall dwell securely.

Sir 4:16 If a man commit himself unto her, he shall inherit her; and his generation shall hold her in possession.

Sir 4:17 For at the first she will walk with him by crooked ways, and bring fear and dread upon him, and torment him with her discipline, until she may trust his soul, and try him by her laws.

Sir 4:18 Then will she return the straight way unto him, and comfort him, and shew him her secrets.

Wis 7:27 And being but one, she can do all things: and remaining in herself, she maketh all things new: and in all ages entering into holy souls, she maketh them friends of Alahayim, and prophets.



Ezekiel 34:13

And I will bring them out from the people, and gather them from the countries, and will bring them to their own land, and feed them upon the mountains of Israel by the rivers, and in all the inhabited places of the country.

Ezekiel 34:14 I will feed them in a good pasture, and upon the high mountains of Israel shall their fold be: there shall they lie in a good fold, and in a fat pasture shall they feed upon the mountains of Israel.

Ezekiel 34:15 I will feed my flock, and I will cause them to lie down, saith the Lord Ahayah.

Ezekiel 34:16 I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with judgment.

Ezekiel 34:22 Therefore will I save my flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle.

Ezekiel 34:23 And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd.

Ezekiel 34:24

And I Ahayah will be their Alahayim, and my servant David a prince among them; I Ahayah have spoken it.

Isaiah 11:10

And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

Jeremiah 3:15

And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

2 Esdras 2:17

Fear not, thou mother of the children: for I have chosen thee, saith the Lord.

2 Esdras 2:18 For thy help will I send my servants Esau and Jeremy, after whose counsel I have sanctified and prepared for thee twelve trees laden with divers fruits,

2 Esdras 2:19 And as many fountains flowing with milk and honey, and seven mighty mountains, whereupon there grow roses and lilies, whereby I will fill thy children with joy.



Jeremiah 23:3

And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.

Jeremiah 23:4 And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith Ahayah.

1Jn 4:18

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love

1Jn 5:3 For this is the love of Alahayim, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

1Jn 4:17

Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

1Jn 3:7

Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

1Jn 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Alahayim was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

1Jn 2:28

And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.

Mat 7:22

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works?

Mat 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Ezekiel 34:31 And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your Alahayim, saith the Lord Ahayah.

Isa 4:5

And Ahayah will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory *shall be* a defence.

Isa 4:6 And there shall be a tabernacle for a shadow in the daytime from the heat, and for a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain.

Isa 4:2 In that day shall the branch of Ahayah be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth *shall be* excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel.

Isa 4:3 And it shall come to pass, *that he that is* left in Zion, and *he that* remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, *even* every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem:

Isa 4:4 When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion,

Ephesians 5:26

....and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

Accept no person against thy soul, and let not the reverence of any man cause thee to fall.

Ecclesiasticus 4:27 Make not thyself an underling to a foolish man; neither accept the person of the mighty.

Righteous Parents

And they were both righteous before Alahayim, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.

Proverbs 24:16 For a just man falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

Psalms of Solomon 3

7. The steadfastness of the righteous is from Alahayim, their deliverer; There lodgeth not in the house of the righteous sin upon sin.

8. The righteous continually searcheth his house, To remove utterly all iniquity done by him in error.

5. The righteous stumbleth and holdeth Ahayah righteous: He falleth and looketh out for what Alahayim will do to him;

6. He seeketh out whence his deliverance will come

Luke 8:15

But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.

Her parents also were righteous,
and taught their daughter according to the law of Moses.

The fear of the Lord goeth before the obtaining of authority: but roughness and pride is
the losing thereof.

For the Lord hath given the father honour over the children, ...

Pro 15:33

The fear of Ahayah is the instruction of wisdom; and before honour is humility.

Pro 29:23

A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.

Sir 2:17

They that fear the Lord will prepare their hearts, and humble their souls in his sight,

Sirach 3:2

...and hath confirmed the authority of the mother over the sons.

1 Timothy 5:14

I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give
none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

Titus 2:4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to
love their children,

Titus 2:5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands,
that the word of Alahayim be not blasphemed.

Of these also four are more powerful than the rest; the first is Unbelief; the second, Intemperance; the third, Disobedience; the fourth, Deceit; and their followers are called, Sadness, Wickedness, Wantonness, Irascibility, Falsehood, Folly, Slander, Hatred. The servant of Alahayim that beareth these names shall see the kingdom of Alahayim, but shall not enter into it."
