



The Truth of the Gospel is Your Walk

1 Corinthians 13:1-8

[1] Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

[2] And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

[3] And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

[4] Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

[5] Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

[6] Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

[7] Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

[8] Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.

Testament of Dan 6:8-10

8 Keep, therefore, yourselves, my children, from every evil work, And cast away wrath and all lying, And love truth and long-suffering. 9 And the things which ye have heard from your father, do ye also impart to your children [that the Saviour of the Gentiles may receive you; for he is true and long-suffering, meek and lowly, and 10 teacheth by his works the law of Alahayim]. Depart, therefore, from all unrighteousness, and cleave unto the righteousness of Alahayim, and your race will be saved for ever. I'll

2 Corinthians 1:12

[12] For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and holy sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of Alahayim, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward.

Romans 14:13



[13]Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.

Acts 24:16

[16]And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward Alahayim, and toward men.

Galatians 6:4-5

[4]But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

[5]For every man shall bear his own burden.

1 Corinthians 9:27

[27]But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5

[4]And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

[5]That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of Alahayim.

1 Corinthians 4:20-21

[20]For the kingdom of Alahayim is not in word, but in power.

[21]What will ye? shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and in the spirit of meekness?

Colossians 1:11

[11]Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

Philippians 3:13-17

[13]Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

[14]I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of Alahayim in Christ Yache.

[15]Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, a Alahayim shall reveal even this unto you.



[16]Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing.

[17]Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5

[3]For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh:

[4](For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through Alahayim to the pulling down of strong holds;)

[5]Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of Alahayim, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

1 Peter 3:1-2

[1]Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

[2]While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.

1 Corinthians 16:13-14

[13]Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.

[14]Let all your things be done with charity.

James 3:13-18

[13]Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.

[14]But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

[15]This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

[16]For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

[17]But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to



be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

[18]And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

1 Timothy 4:12

[12]Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.
