

# Confess Your Faults

Hosea 5:15

I will go *and* return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early

Lev 26:39

And they that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them.

Lev 26:40

If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me;

Lev 26:41

And *that* I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:

Lev 26:42

Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.


Mar 1:4

John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins

Mar 1:14

Now after that John was put in prison, Yache came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of Alahayim,

Mar 1:15



And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of Alahayim is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Mar 1:5

And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins

Mat 3:8

Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance

Luk 8:15

But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep *it*, and bring forth fruit with patience

Psa 11:4 The LORD *is* in his holy temple, the LORD'S throne *is* in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of Alahayim

He looketh upon men, and *if any* say, I have sinned, and perverted *that which was* right, and it profited me not;

Job 33:28


He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light

Psalms of solomon 3:3-10

3. The righteous remember AHAYAH at all times,

With thanksgiving and declaration of the righteousness of AHAYAH's judgements.

4. The righteous despiseth not the chastening of AHAYAH; His will is always before AHAYAH.



5. The righteous stumbleth and holdeth AHAYAH righteous: He falleth and looketh out for what Alahayim will do to him;
6. He seeketh out whence his deliverance will come.
7. The steadfastness of the righteous is from Alahayim, their deliverer;
8. There lodgeth not in the house of the righteous sin upon sin. The righteous continually searcheth his house,
9. To remove utterly all iniquity done by him in error.
10. He maketh atonement for sins of ignorance by fasting and afflicting his soul, And AHAYAH counteth guiltless every pious man and his house

#### Romans 10:10

10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation

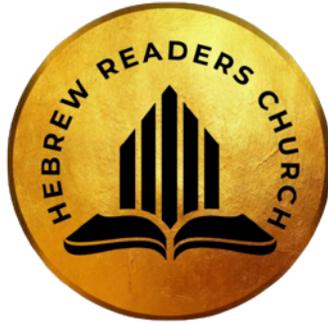
#### Jer 3:12

Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say, Return, thou backsliding Israel, saith the LORD; *and* I will not cause mine anger to fall upon you: for I *am* merciful, saith the LORD, *and* I will not keep *anger* for ever.

#### Jer 3:13

Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy Alahayim, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD.

#### Jer 3:14



Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD; for I am married unto you: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to Zion:

Jer 3:15

And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

Lev 5:1

And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and is a witness, whether he hath seen or known *of it*; if he do not utter *it*, then he shall bear his iniquity.

Lev 5:2

Or if a soul touch any unclean thing, whether *it be* a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and *if it be* hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty.

Lev 5:3

Or if he touch the uncleanness of man, whatsoever uncleanness *it be* that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth *of it*, then he shall be guilty.

Lev 5:4

Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with *his lips* to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever *it be* that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth *of it*, then he shall be guilty in one of these.


Lev 5:5

And it shall be, when he shall be guilty in one of these *things*, that he shall confess that he hath sinned in that *thing*:

Lev 5:6

And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD for his sin which he hath sinned, a female from the flock, a lamb or a kid of the goats, for a sin offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his sin.

Psa 19:7



The law of the LORD *is* perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD *is* sure, making wise the simple.

Psa 19:8

The statutes of the LORD *are* right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD *is* pure, enlightening the eyes.

Psa 19:9

The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.

Psa 15:1

A Psalm of David. LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? who shall dwell in thy holy hill?

Psa 15:2

He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart

Psa 19:12

Who can understand *his* errors? cleanse thou me from secret *faults*.

Psa 19:13

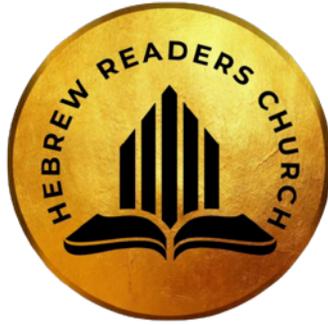
Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous *sins*; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.

Proverbs 28:13

13 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy

Sir 4:25

In no wise speak against the truth; but be abashed of the error of thine ignorance.



Sir 4:20

Observe the opportunity, and beware of evil; and be not ashamed when it concerneth thy soul.

Sir 4:21

For there is a shame that bringeth sin; and there is a shame which is glory and grace.

Sir 4:22

Accept no person against thy soul, and let not the reverence of any man cause thee to fall.

Sir 4:26

Be not ashamed to confess thy sins; and force not the course of the river

#### Jeremiah 31:18-20

18 I have surely heard Ephraim bemoaning himself *thus*; Thou hast chastised me, and I was chastised, as a bullock unaccustomed *to the yoke*: turn thou me, and I shall be turned; for thou *art* the LORD my Alahayim.

19 Surely after that I was turned, I repented; and after that I was instructed, I smote upon *my* thigh: I was ashamed, yea, even confounded, because I did bear the reproach of my youth.

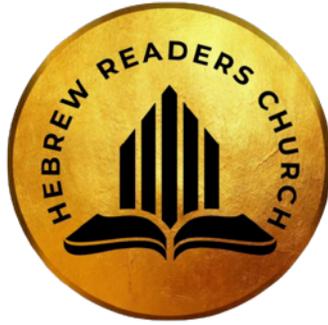
20 *Is* Ephraim my dear son? *is he* a pleasant child? for since I spake against him, I do earnestly remember him still: therefore my bowels are troubled for him; I will surely have mercy upon him, saith the LORD.

Sir 7:5

justify not thyself before the Lord; and boast not of thy wisdom before the king

Job 9:20

If I justify myself, mine own mouth shall condemn me: *if I say*, I *am* perfect, it shall also prove me perverse.



Job 9:21

*Though I were perfect, yet would I not know my soul: I would despise my life*

Luk 18:9

And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

Luk 18:10

Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

Luk 18:11

The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, Alahayim, I thank thee, that I am not as other men *are*, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

Luk 18:12

I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

Luk 18:13

And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as *his* eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, Alahayim be merciful to me a sinner.

Luk 18:14

I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *rather* than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted

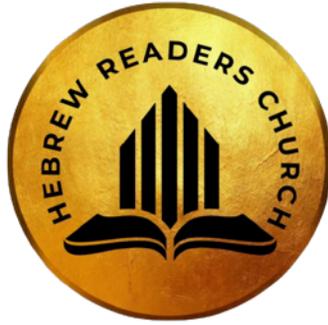
1 John 1:8-10

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us

Psalms 32:5



5 I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah

Psa 32:6

For this shall every one that is alahayimly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him.

Jas 5:14

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Jas 5:15

And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Jas 5:16

Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much
