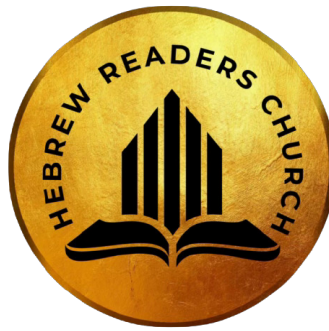
And Alahayim called the dry *land* Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and Alahayim saw that *it was* good.

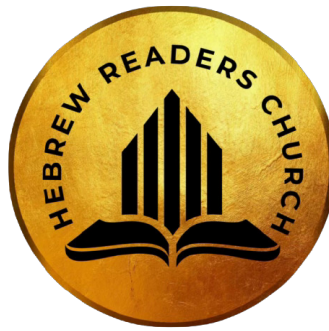

Enoch 77:1-2

1. And the first quarter is called the east, because it is the first: and the second, the south, because the Most High will descend there, yea, there in quite a special sense will He who is blessed for ever descend .2. And the west quarter is named the diminished, because there all the luminaries of the heaven wane and go down.

Apocalypse of Paul 31

Enoch 77:5-8

5. I saw seven rivers on the earth larger than all the rivers: one of them coming from the west pours its waters into the Great Sea.

6. And these two come from the north to the sea and pour their waters into the Erythraean Sea in the east.

7. And the remaining, four come forth on the side of the north to their own sea, two of them to the Erythraean Sea, and two into the Great Sea and discharge themselves there [and some say: into the desert].



8. Seven great islands I saw in the sea and in the mainland: two in the mainland and five in the Great Sea.

Enoch 77:4

4. I saw seven high mountains, higher than all the mountains which are on the earth: and thence comes forth hoar-frost, and days, seasons, and years pass away

1. **the Denali**, also known as **Mount McKinley**, is the highest mountain peak in North America and it's up in Alaska.
2. **Aconcagua** is a mountain in the Andes mountain range, Argentina. Highest in the Americas
3. **Mount Kilimanjaro** is a dormant volcano in Tanzania Africa. It's among volcanic mountains in the East Africa rift zone, scriprurally known as the mountains of fire in the land of Ham according to jubilees 8:22
4. **Mont Blanc** is the highest mountain in the Alps and Western Europe, and stands between the regions of Italy, and France.
5. **Mount Elbrus** , the dormant volcano, is the highest and most prominent peak in Russia and Europe. It is the highest peak of the Caucasus Mountains.
6. **Mount Everest** is Earth's highest mountain located in the Himalayas Of east Asia. biblically this Mount Everest is called Rafa in Jubilees 8:16. And the Himalayas are the mountain range of Rafa in jubilees 8:12.
7. the **Puncak Jaya** (or **Mount Jayawijaya** or **Mount Carstensz** is the highest mountain in Indonesia, on the island of New Guinea, off the coasts of China.

Enoch 33:1-2

Chapter 33, XXXIII

1. And from thence I went to the ends of the earth and saw there great beasts, and each differed from the other; and (I saw) birds also differing in appearance and beauty and voice, the one differing from the other.

2. And to the east of those beasts I saw the ends of the earth whereon the heaven rests, and the portals of the heaven open.

Enoch 72:3

3. And I saw six portals in which the sun rises, and six portals in which the sun sets and the moon rises and sets in these portals, and the leaders of the stars and those whom they lead: six in the east and six in the west, and all following each other in accurately corresponding order: also many windows to the right and left of these portals.



Enoch 72:2

2. And this is the first law of the luminaries: the luminary the Sun has its rising in the eastern portals of the heaven, and its setting in the western portals of the heaven.

Enoch 78:5

5. And they set and enter the portals of the west, and make their revolution by the north, and come forth through the eastern portals on the face of the heaven.

Enoch 72:2

1. The book of the courses of the luminaries of the heaven, the relations of each, according to their classes, their dominion and their seasons, according to their names and places of origin, and according to their months, which Uriel, the holy angel, who was with me, who is their guide, showed me; and he showed me all their laws exactly as they are, and how it is with regard to all the years of the world and unto eternity, till the new creation is accomplished which dureth till eternity.

2. And this is the first law of the luminaries: the luminary the Sun has its rising in the eastern portals of the heaven, and its setting in the western portals of the heaven. .

5. The chariot on which he ascends, the wind drives, and the sun goes down from the heaven and returns through the north in order to reach the east, and is so guided that he comes to the appropriate portal and shines in the face of the heaven.

6. In this way he rises in the first month in the great portal, which is the fourth [those six portals in the east]

. 8. When the sun rises in the heaven, he comes forth through that fourth portal thirty, mornings in succession, and sets accurately in the fourth portal in the west of the heaven. 9. And during this period the day becomes daily longer and the night nightly shorter to the thirtieth morning.

Jubilees 2:9

. 9. And Alahayim appointed the sun to be a great sign on the earth for days and for Sabbaths and for months and for feasts and for years and for Sabbaths of years and for jubilees and for all seasons of the years.

Enoch 18:6-14

6 And I proceeded and saw a place which burns day and night, where there are seven mountains of magnificent stones, three towards the east, and three towards the south. 7. And as for those towards the east, was of coloured stone, and one of pearl, and one of jacinth, and those towards the south of red stone. 8. But the middle one reached to heaven like the throne of Alahayim, of alabaster, and the summit of the throne was of sapphire. 9. And I saw a flaming fire. 10. And beyond these mountains is a region the end of the great earth: there the heavens were completed.

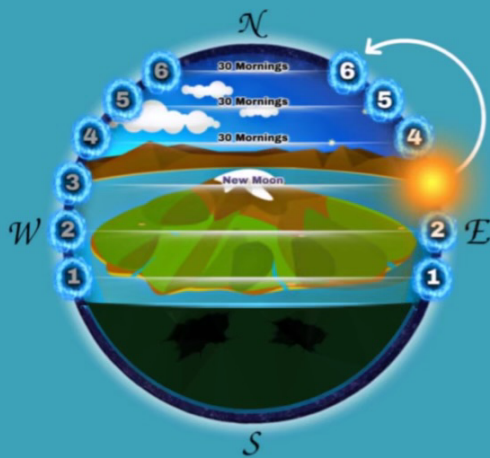


11. And I saw a deep abyss, with columns of heavenly fire, and among them I saw columns of fire fall, which were beyond measure alike towards the height and towards the depth. 12. And beyond that abyss I saw a place which had no firmament of the heaven above, and no firmly founded earth beneath it: there was no water upon it, and no birds, but it was a waste and horrible place. 13. I saw there seven stars like great burning mountains, and to me, when I inquired regarding them, 14. The angel said: 'This place is the end of heaven and earth:

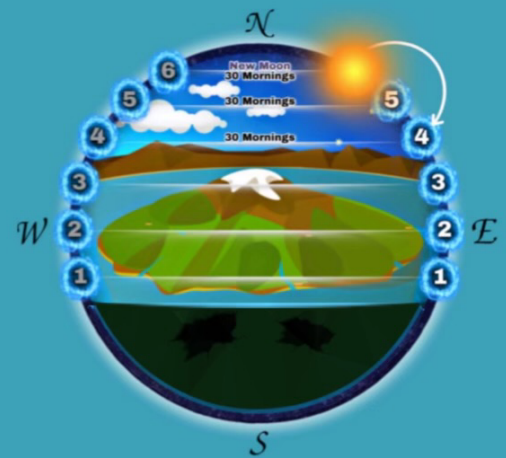


The Sun begins the year in the 4th portal (30 days), then its circuit travels through the 5th portal (30 days) unto the 6th portal. (31 days including the New Moon) Then turns back unto the 6th portal (30 days) and unto the 5th portal (30 days) then unto the 4th portal (31 days including the New Moon) and unto to the 3rd portal (30 days) and unto the 2nd portal (30 days) then it travels unto the 1st portal (31 days including the New Moon). The Sun then turns back unto the 1st portal (30 days) and unto the 2nd portal (30 days) then lastly unto the 3rd portal (31 days including the new moon) to complete its circuit for the complete year (364 days).

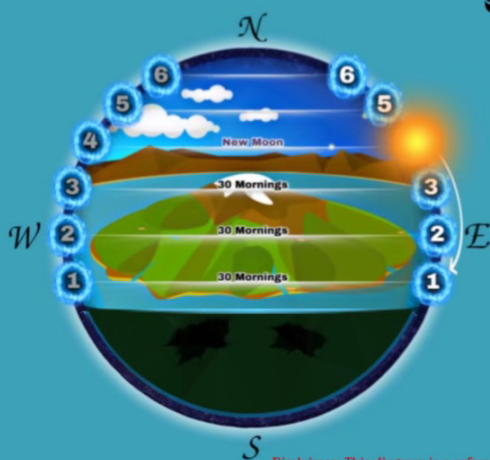
THE SUN'S CIRCUIT:  
SPRING SEASON



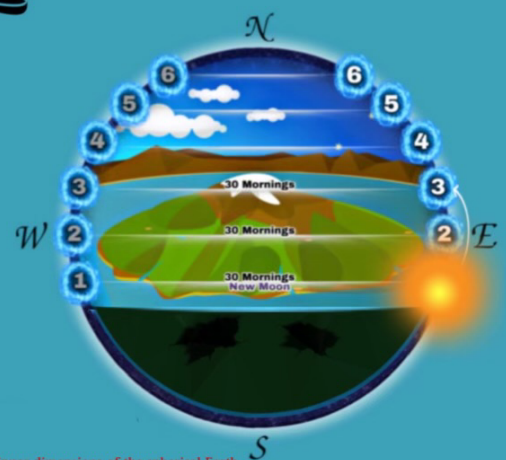
THE SUN'S CIRCUIT:

FALL SEASON

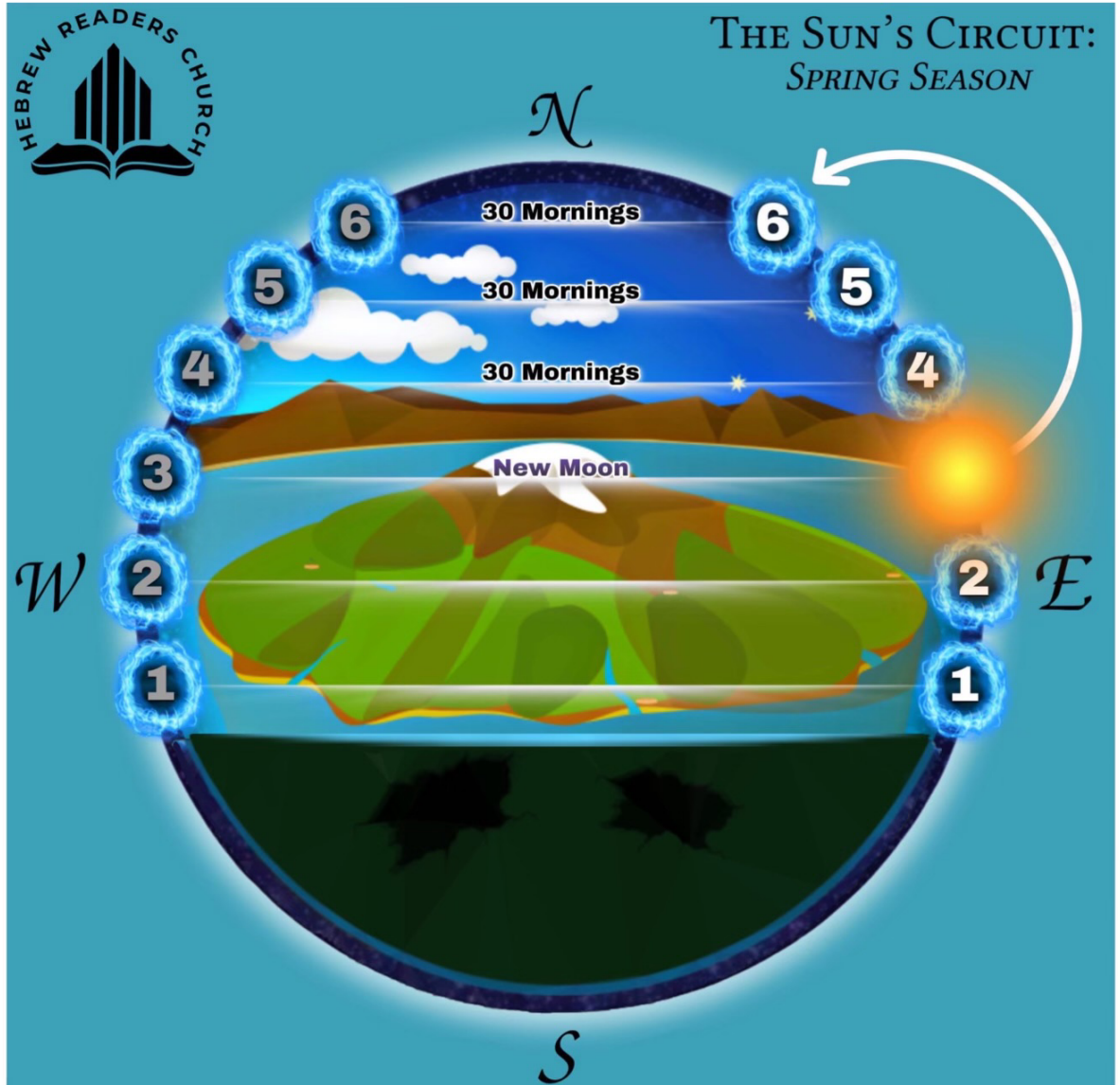
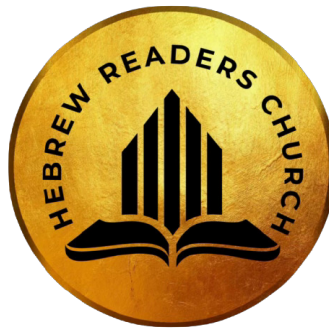


THE SUN'S CIRCUIT:  
WINTER SEASON



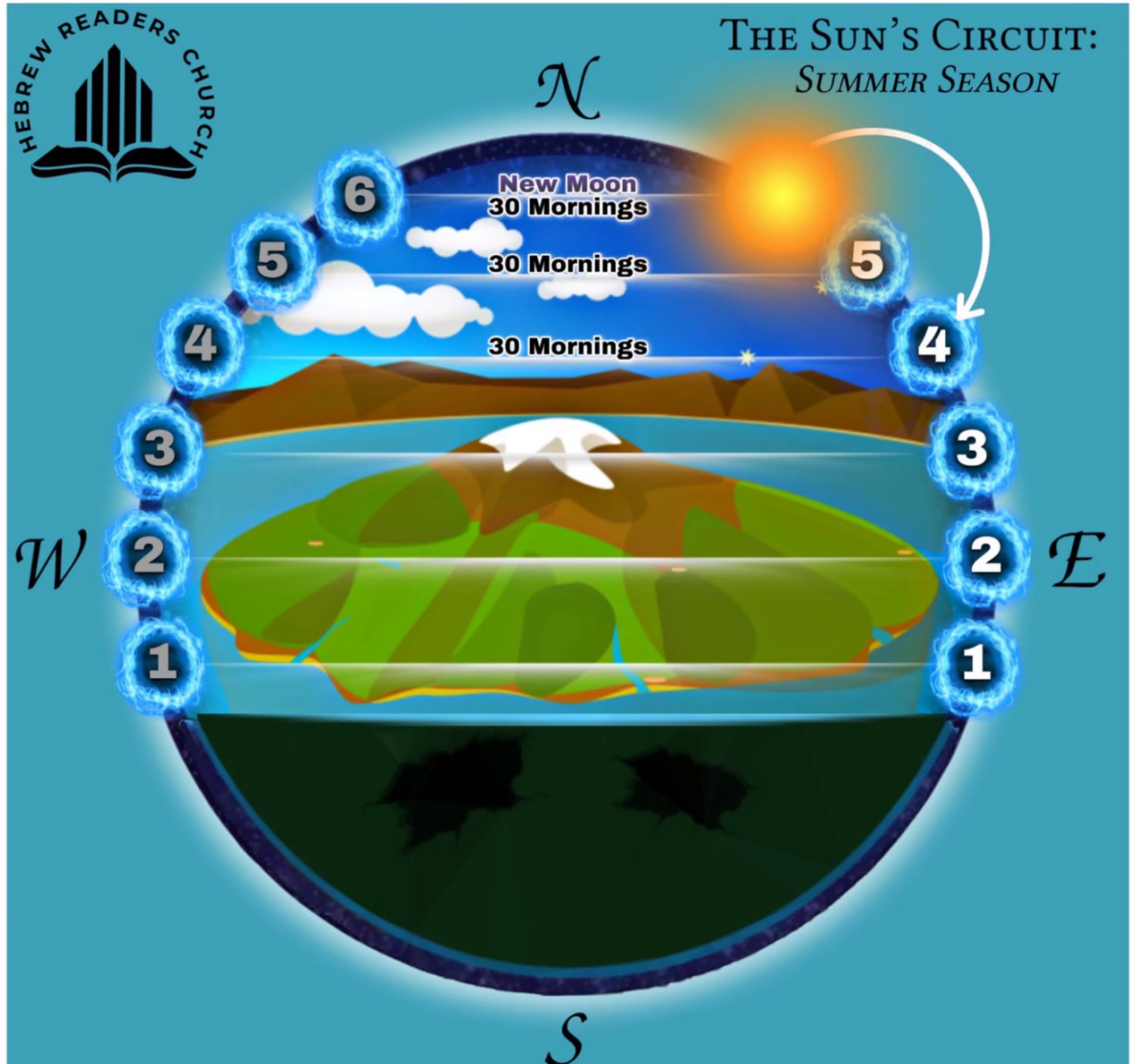
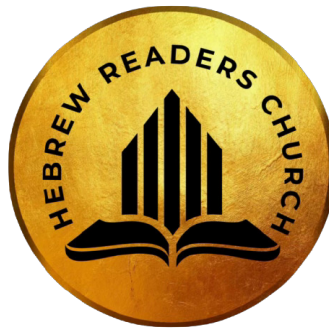

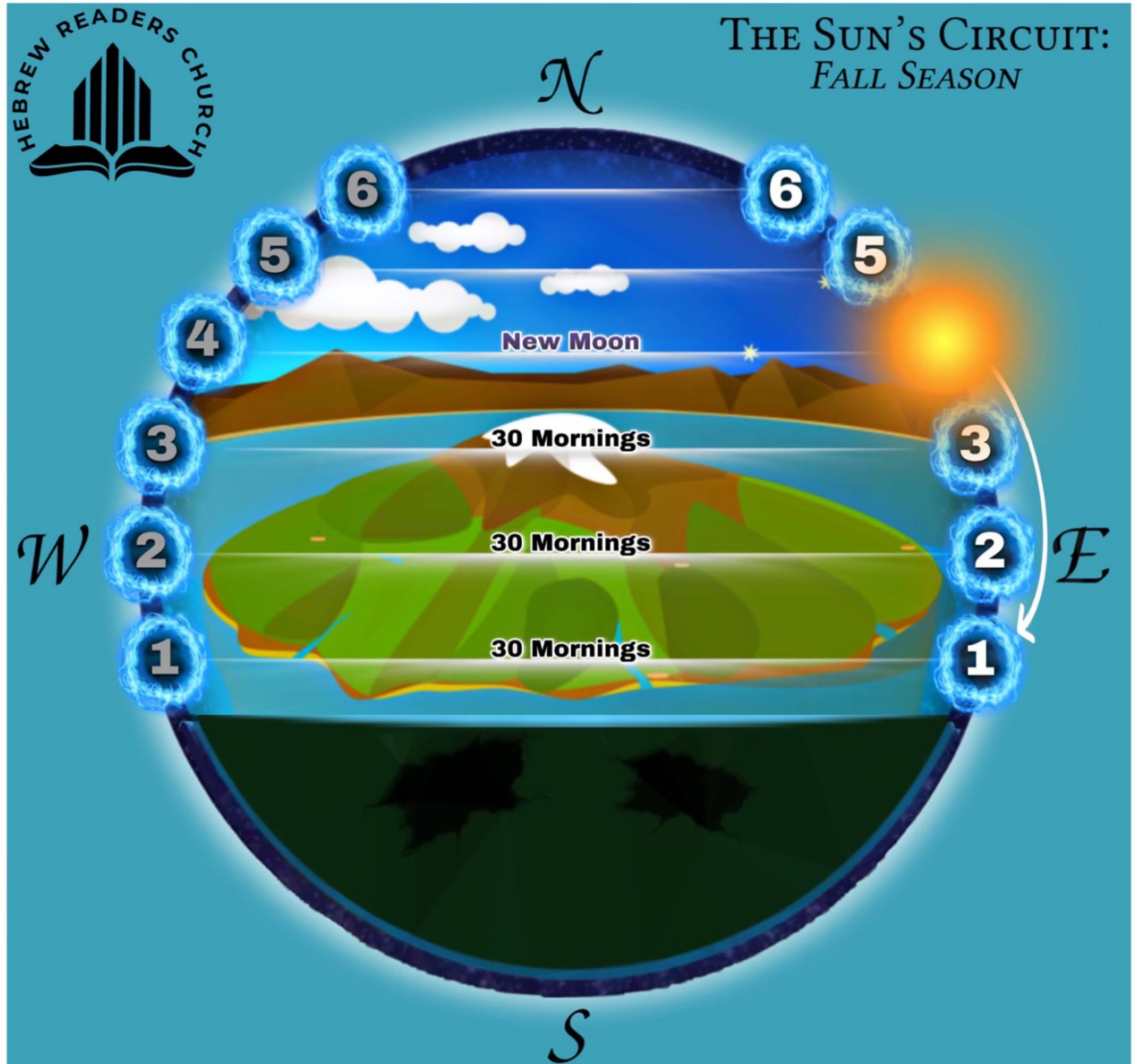

The Spring season lasts 91 days. At the beginning of the Spring season the Sun rises in the 3rd portal for 1 morning completing the end of the year: The New Moon. After that, it then transitions to start the new year in the 4th portal, rising for 30 mornings. Once complete, it rises in the 5th portal (30 mornings) and finishes its circuit rising in the 6th portal (30 mornings) to complete the 91 days of Spring season.



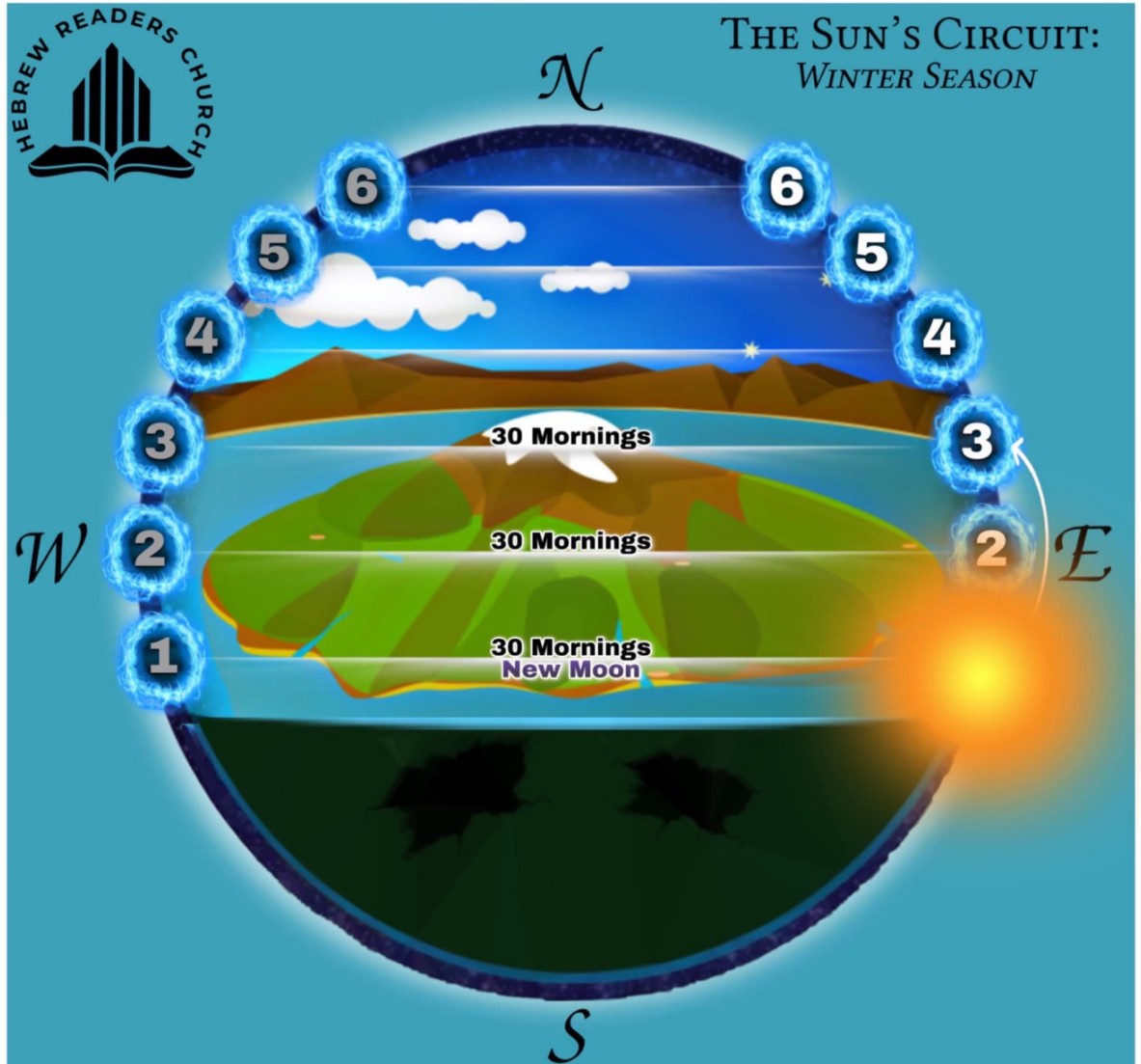
*Disclaimer: This diagram is a reference pertaining to the inner dimensions of the spherical Earth.*

The Summer season lasts 91 days. During the Summer season the Sun rises in the 6th portal for a total of 31 days: One New Moon and 30 mornings following. After that's complete, it rises in the 5th portal (30 mornings) and then finishes its circuit rising in the 4th portal (30 mornings) to complete the 91 days of Summer season.



**Disclaimer:** This diagram is a reference pertaining to the inner dimensions of the spherical Earth.

The Fall season lasts 91 days. During the Fall season, the Sun rises in the 4th portal for 1 morning: the New Moon. After that's complete, it transitions to rise in the 3rd portal for 30 mornings, then rises in the 2nd portal (30 mornings) and finishes its circuit rising in the 1st portal (30 mornings) to complete the 91 days of Fall season.



Disclaimer: This diagram is a reference pertaining to the inner dimensions of the spherical Earth.

The Winter season lasts 91 days. During the Winter season the Sun rises in the 1st portal for a total of 31 days: the New Moon and 30 mornings following. After that's complete, it rises in the 2nd portal (30 mornings) and finishes its circuit rising in the 3rd portal (30 mornings) to complete the 91 days of Winter season.
