

The Days are Evil: Avoid a Reprobate Mind

John 14:6

[6]Yache saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Original: ὁδός

Transliteration: hodos

Phonetic: hod-os'

Thayer Definition:

Properly a way, a travelled way, road a travellers way, journey, travelling

Metaphorically: a course of conduct a way, (i.e. manner) of thinking, feeling, deciding

Strong's Definition: Apparently a primary word; a road; by implication a progress (the route, act or distance); figuratively a mode or means: - journey, (high-) way.

Matthew 10:38

[38] And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.

Romans 10:4

[4] For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.



1 Peter 2:20-23

[20] For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with Alahayim.

[21] For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

[22] Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

[23] Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

[30] And why stand we in jeopardy every hour?

[31] I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Yache our Lord, I die daily.

Ecclesiasticus 4:17

[17] For at the first she will walk with him by crooked ways, and bring fear and dread upon him, and torment him with her discipline, until she may trust his soul, and try him by her laws.



Romans 7:12

[12]Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

Romans 7:10,13

[10] And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death.

[13] Was then that which is good made death unto me? Alahayim forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful.

[12]Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.

[13] Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto Alahayim, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto Alahayim.

[14] For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

[15] What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? Alahayim forbid.

[16]Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

Romans 8:13

[13] For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Original: ἀδόκιμος

Transliteration: adokimos

Phonetic: ad-ok'-ee-mos

Thayer Definition:

not standing the test, not approved, properly used of metals and coins, that which does not prove itself such as it ought, unfit for, unproved, spurious, reprobate

Strong's Definition: From G1 (as a negative particle)

and G1384; unapproved, that is, rejected; by implication worthless (literally or morally): - castaway, rejected, reprobate.



Hermas vision 3

7[15]:1 "But the other stones which thou sawest cast far away from the tower and falling into the way and rolling out of the way into the regions where there is no way, these are they that have believed, but by reason of their double heart they abandon their true way. Thus thinking that they can find a better way, they go astray and are sore distressed, as they walk about in the regions where there is no way. 7[15]:2 But they that fall into the fire and are burned, these are they that finally rebelled from the living Alahayim, and it no more entered into their hearts to repent by reason of the lusts of their wantonness and of the wickednesses which they wrought. 7[15]:3 But the others, which are near the waters and yet cannot roll into the water, wouldest thou know who are they? These are they that heard the word, and would be baptized unto the name of Ahayah. Then, when they call to their remembrance the purity of the truth, they change their minds, and go back again after their evil desires." 7[15]:4 So she finished the explanation of the tower.

1 Kings 3:14

[14]And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

1 Kings 15:5

[57] David for being merciful possessed the throne of an everlasting kingdom.

[1]And he brought out of him a merciful man, which found favour in the sight of all flesh, even Moses,

beloved of Alahayim and men, whose memorial is blessed.

Psalms of Solomon 3:

- 3. The righteous remember Ahayah at all times, With thanksgiving and declaration of the righteousness of Ahayah's judgements.
- 4. The righteous despiseth not the chastening of Ahayah; His will is always before Ahayah.
- 5. The righteous stumbleth and holdeth Ahayah righteous: He falleth and looketh out for what

Alahayim will do to him;

- 6. He seeketh out whence his deliverance will come.
- 7. The steadfastness of the righteous is from Alahayim, their deliverer; There lodgeth not in the house of the righteous sin upon sin.
- 8. The righteous continually searcheth his house, To remove utterly all iniquity done by him in error.
- 9. He maketh atonement for sins of ignorance by fasting and afflicting his soul,
- 10. And Ahayah counteth guiltless every pious man and his house.
- 11. The sinner stumbleth and curseth his life The day when he was begotten, and his mother's travail.
- 12. He addeth sins to sins, while he liveth;
