

# The Baptism of Fire

John 3:5 Yache answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of Alahayim.

John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

John 3:8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Matthew 3:1 In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,

Matthew 3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew 3:3 For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.

Matthew 3:4 And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

Matthew 3:5 Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,

Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

Matthew 3:12 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will throughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

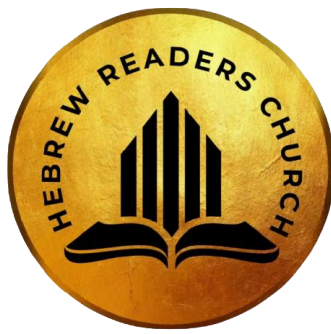
Isaiah 48:10 Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction.

Malachi 3:1 Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

Malachi 3:2 But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for he is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap:

Malachi 3:3 And he shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness.

Wisdom of Solomon 6:12 Wisdom is glorious, and never fadeth away: yea, she is easily seen of them that love her, and found of such as seek her.



Wisdom of Solomon 6:13 She preventeth them that desire her, in making herself first known unto them.

Wisdom of Solomon 6:14 Whoso seeketh her early shall have no great travail: for he shall find her sitting at his doors.

Wisdom of Solomon 6:15 To think therefore upon her is perfection of wisdom: and whoso watcheth for her shall quickly be without care.

Wisdom of Solomon 6:16 For she goeth about seeking such as are worthy of her, sheweth herself favourably unto them in the ways, and meeteth them in every thought.

Wisdom of Solomon 6:17 For the very true beginning of her is the desire of discipline; and the care of discipline is love;

John 17:21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

John 17:22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

Wisdom of Solomon 6:18 And love is the keeping of her laws; and the giving heed unto her laws is the assurance of incorruption;

Wisdom of Solomon 6:19 And incorruption maketh us near unto Alahayim:

Wisdom of Solomon 6:20 Therefore the desire of wisdom bringeth to a kingdom.

Ecclesiasticus 24:18 I am the mother of fair love, and fear, and knowledge, and holy hope: I therefore, being eternal, am given to all my children which are named of him.

Ecclesiasticus 24:19 Come unto me, all ye that be desirous of me, and fill yourselves with my fruits.

Ecclesiasticus 2:1 My son, if thou come to serve the Lord, prepare thy soul for temptation.

Ecclesiasticus 2:2 Set thy heart aright, and constantly endure, and make not haste in time of trouble.

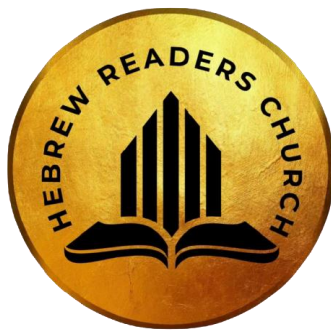
Ecclesiasticus 2:3 Cleave unto him, and depart not away, that thou mayest be increased at thy last end.

Ecclesiasticus 2:4 Whatsoever is brought upon thee take cheerfully, and be patient when thou art changed to a low estate.

Ecclesiasticus 2:5 For gold is tried in the fire, and acceptable men in the furnace of adversity.

Ecclesiasticus 4:17 For at the first she will walk with him by crooked ways, and bring fear and dread upon him, and torment him with her discipline, until she may trust his soul, and try him by her laws.

Ecclesiasticus 4:18 Then will she return the straight way unto him, and comfort him, and shew him her secrets.



Ecclesiasticus 4:19 But if he go wrong, she will forsake him, and give him over to his own ruin.

Wisdom of Solomon 1:4 For into a malicious soul wisdom shall not enter; nor dwell in the body that is subject unto sin.

Wisdom of Solomon 1:5 For the holy spirit of discipline will flee deceit, and remove from thoughts that are without understanding, and will not abide when unrighteousness cometh in.

Ecclesiasticus 4:20 Observe the opportunity, and beware of evil; and be not ashamed when it concerneth thy soul.

Isaiah 30:20 And though the Lord give you the bread of adversity, and the water of affliction, yet shall not thy teachers be removed into a corner any more, but thine eyes shall see thy teachers:

Isaiah 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Isaiah 30:22 Ye shall defile also the covering of thy graven images of silver, and the ornament of thy molten images of gold: thou shalt cast them away as a menstruous cloth; thou shalt say unto it, Get thee hence.
