



Understanding the Calendar: A Complete Day

Jubilees 2:2-3

2. For on the first day He created the heavens which are above and the earth and the waters and all the spirits which serve before Him--the angels of the presence, and the angels of sanctification, and the angels [of the spirit of fire and the angels] of the spirit of the winds, and the angels of the spirit of the clouds, and of darkness, and of snow and of hail and of hoar frost, and the angels of the voices and of the thunder and of the lightning, and the angels of the spirits of cold and of heat, and of winter and of spring and of autumn and of summer, and of all the spirits of His creatures which are in the heavens and on the earth, (He created) the abysses and the darkness, eventide (and night), and the light, dawn and day, which He hath prepared in the knowledge of His heart.

3. And thereupon we saw His works, and praised Him, and lauded before Him on account of all His works; for seven great works did He create on the first day.

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning Alahayim created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 1:2

And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep.

And the Spirit of Alahayim moved upon the face of the waters.

Genesis 1:3

And Alahayim said, Let there be light: and there was light.

Genesis 1:4

And Alahayim saw the light, that it was good: and Alahayim divided the light from the darkness.

Genesis 1:5

And Alahayim called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.



2Es 14:3

Then said he unto me, In the bush I did manifestly reveal myself unto Moses, and talked with him, when my people served in Egypt:

2Es 14:4

And I sent him and led my people out of Egypt, and brought him up to the mount of where I held him by me a long season,

2Es 14:5

And told him many wondrous things, and shewed him the secrets of the times, and the end; and commanded him, saying,

2Es 14:6

These words shalt thou declare, and these shalt thou hide.

Jubilees 49:10

10. Let the children of Israel come and observe the Passover on the day of its fixed time, on the fourteenth day of the first month, between the evenings, from the third part of the day to the third part of the night, for two portions of the day are given to the light, and a third part to the evening.

Jubilee 49:12

12. And it is not permissible to slay it during any period of the light, but during the period bordering on the evening

John 20:1

The first day of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

John 20:19

Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.

Jubilees 2:9-10

9. And Alahayim appointed the sun to be a great sign on the earth for days and for Sabbaths and for months and for feasts and for years and for Sabbaths of years and for jubilees and for all seasons of the years.

10. And it divideth the light from the darkness.....

Enoch 77:2

And the west quarter is named diminished, because there all the luminaries of the heaven wane and go down.



Deu 23:10

If there be among you any man, that is not clean by reason of uncleanness that chanceth him by night, then shall he go abroad out of the camp, he shall not come within the camp:

Deu 23:11

But it shall be, when evening cometh on, he shall wash himself with water: and when the sun is down, he shall come into the camp again.

Lev 22:6

The soul which hath touched any such shall be unclean until even, and shall not eat of the holy things, unless he wash his flesh with water.

Lev 22:7

And when the sun is down, he shall be clean, and shall afterward eat of the holy things; because it is his food.

Jubilees 49:10

10. observe the Passover on the day of its fixed time,from the third part of the day to the third part of the night

Jubilee 49:12

12....., and let them eat it at the time of the evening until the third part of the night, and whatever is leftover of all its flesh from the third part of the night and onwards, let them burn it with fire.

Exo 12:10

And ye shall let nothing of it remain until **the morning**; and that which remaineth of it until the morning ye shall burn with fire.

בֶּקֶר

From H1239; properly *dawn* (as the *break* of day); generally *morning*: - (+) day, early, morning, morrow

Jdg 19:25

But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her forth unto them; and they knew her, and abused her all the night until the morning:and when the day began to spring, they let her go



Jdg 19:26

Then came the woman in the dawning of the day, and fell down at the door of the man's house where her lord *was*, till it was light

Wis 16:28

That it might be known, that we must prevent the sun to give thee thanks, and at the dayspring pray unto thee.

Enoch 72:4

4. And first there goes forth the great luminary, named the Sun, and his circumference is like the circumference of the heaven, and he is quite filled with illuminating and heating fire. 5. The chariot on which he ascends, the wind drives, and the sun goes down from the heaven and returns through the north in order to reach the east, and is so guided that he comes to the appropriate portal and shines in the face of the heaven

Mar 1:35

And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed

Mar 14:30

And Yache saith unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this day, *even* in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice
