Sir 7:28 Remember that thou wast begotten of them;

A primitive root; to fear; morally to revere;... reverence ...

- **Revere**: feel deep respect or <u>admiration</u> for (something).
- **Reverence**: deep respect for someone or something. regard or treat with deep respect.

Ephesians 6:2 <u>Honour</u> thy father and mother;

G5091 (<u>Strong</u>)

From <u>G5093</u>; to *prize*, that is, *fix* a *valuation* upon; by implication to *revere*: - honour, value.

<u>Honour</u> thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) Ephesians 6:3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

persist in his wrong-doing, even so forgive him from the heart, and leave to Alahayim the avenging.

From <u>G1722</u> and <u>G2641</u>; to *leave behind in* some place, that is, (in a good sense) *let remain over*, or (in a bad one) to *desert:* - forsake, leave.

Deuteronomy 27:16

Cursed be he that setteth light by his father or his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen.

H7034 (Strong)

קלה

A primitive root; to *be light* (as implied in *rapid* motion), but figuratively only (*be* (causatively *hold*) *in contempt*): - base, contemn, despise, lightly esteem, set light, seem vile.

Proverbs 30:11

There is a generation that curseth their father, and doth not bless their mother. Pro 30:12 There is a generation that are pure in their own eyes, and yet is not washed from their filthiness.

Exodus 21:15

And he that smiteth his father, or his mother, shall be surely put to death. Exodus 21:17

And he that curseth his father, or his mother, shall surely be put to death.

- **Revile**: criticize in an abusive or angrily insulting manner

Lev 20:9

For every one that curseth his father or his mother shall be surely put to death: he hath cursed his father or his mother; his blood *shall be* upon him

Mat 15:4

For Alahayim commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.

G2551 (Strong)

κακολογέω kakologeō kak-ol-og-eh'-o



From a compound of <u>G2556</u> nad <u>G3056</u>; to revile: - curse, speak evil of.

Proverbs 20:20

Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness. Proverbs 30:17

The eye that mocketh at his father, and despiseth to obey his mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it.

Jhn 8:5

Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou?

Jhn 8:7 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

Apocalypse of Peter 11

Furthermore, the angel Ezrael shall bring children and maidens to show them those that are tormented. They shall be chastised with pains, with hanging up (?) and with a multitude of wounds which flesh-devouring birds shall inflict upon them. These are they that boast themselves (trust) in their sins, and obey not their parents and follow not the instruction of their fathers, and honour not them that are more aged than they.
