Unclean meats

Lev 11:39

And if any beast, of which ye may eat, die; he that toucheth the carcase thereof shall be unclean until the even.

Lev 11:40

And he that eateth of the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: he also that beareth the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even.

Lev 17:15

And every soul that eateth that which died *of itself*, or that which was torn *with beasts*, *whether it be* one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe *himself* in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be clean.

Lev 17:16


But if he wash *them* not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his iniquity.

Duet 14:21

Ye shall not eat of any thing that dieth of itself: thou shalt give it unto the stranger that is in thy gates, that he may eat it; or thou mayest sell it unto an alien: for thou art an holy people unto AHAYAH thy Alahayim. Thou shalt not see the a kid in his mother's milk.

Exodus 22:31

31 And ye shall be holy men unto me: neither shall ye eat any flesh that is torn of beasts in the field; ye shall cast it to the dogs.



Deu 14:3

Thou shalt not eat any abominable thing.

Unclean beast:

Duet 14:7-8

7 Nevertheless these ye shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the cloven hoof; as the camel, and the hare, and the coney: for they chew the cud, but divide not the hoof; therefore they are unclean unto you.

8 And the swine, because it divideth the hoof, yet cheweth not the cud, it is unclean unto you: ye shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcase

Lev 4:27

And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth somewhat against any of the commandments of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and be guilty;

Lev 4:28

Or if his sin, which he hath sinned, come to his knowledge: then he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he hath sinned.

2Ma 6:18


Eleazar one of the principal Scribes, an aged man, and of a well favored countenance, was constrained to open his mouth, and to eat swine's flesh.

2Ma 6:19

But he choosing rather to die gloriously, then to live stained with such an abomination, spit it forth, and came of his own accord to the torment,

2Ma 6:20

As it behooved them to come, that are resolute to stand out against such things, as are not lawful for love of life to be tasted.



Unclean ingredients:

Lev 5:2

Or if a soul touch any unclean thing, whether it be a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle,

or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and if it be hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty.

Isa 65:3

A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick;

Isa 65:4

Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels;

4Ma 5:1

The tyrant Antiochus, therefore, sitting in public state with his assessors upon a certain lofty place, with his armed troops standing in a circle around him,

4Ma 5:2


commanded his spearbearers to seize every one of the Hebrews, and to compel them to taste swine's flesh, and things offered to idols.

Lev 11:10-12

And all that have not fins and scales in the seas, and in the rivers, of all that move in the waters, and of any living thing which is in the waters, they shall be an abomination unto you:

Lev 11:11

They shall be even an abomination unto you; ye shall not eat of their flesh, but ye shall have their carcasses in abomination.

Lev 11:12

Whatsoever hath no fins nor scales in the waters, that shall be an abomination unto you.

Deuteronomy 14:12-19

12 But these are they of which ye shall not eat: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray,


13 And the glede, and the kite, and the vulture after his kind,

Swan definition: Swans are birds of the family Anatidae within the genus Cygnus. The swans' closest relatives include the geese and ducks.

The rails, or Rallidae, are a large cosmopolitan family of small- to medium-sized, ground-living birds. The family exhibits considerable diversity and includes the crakes, coots, and gallinules. Many species are associated with wetlands, although the family is found in every terrestrial habitat except dry deserts, polar regions, and alpine areas above the snow line. Members of the Rallidae occur on every continent except Antarctica. Numerous island species are known. The most common rail habitats are marshland and dense forest. They are especially fond of dense vegetation.

17 And the pelican, and the gier eagle, and the cormorant,


18 And the stork, and the heron after her kind, and the lapwing, and the bat.

Unclean beasts that have hoofs

Lev 11:24

And for these ye shall be unclean: whosoever toucheth the carcass of them shall be unclean until the even.

Lev 11:25

And whosoever beareth ought of the carcass of them shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even.

Lev 11:26

The carcasses of every beast which divideth the hoof, and is not clovenfooted, nor cheweth the cud, are unclean unto you: every one that toucheth them shall be unclean.

Lev 11:27


And whatsoever goeth upon his paws, among all manner of beasts that go on all four, those are unclean unto you: whoso toucheth their carcass shall be unclean until the even.

Lev 11:28

And he that beareth the carcass of them shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: they are unclean unto you.

The Creeping things

Lev 11:29



These also shall be unclean unto you among the creeping things that creep upon the earth; the weasel, and the mouse, and the tortoise after his kind,

Lev 11:30

And the ferret, and the chameleon, and the lizard, and the snail, and the mole.

Lev 11:31

These are unclean to you among all that creep: whosoever doth touch them, when they be dead, shall be unclean until the even.

Lev 11:32

And upon whatsoever any of them, when they are dead, doth fall, it shall be unclean; whether it be any vessel of wood, or raiment, or skin, or sack, whatsoever vessel it be, wherein any work is done, it must be put into water, and it shall be unclean until the even; so it shall be cleansed.

Lev 11:34

Of all meat which may be eaten, that on which such water cometh shall be unclean: and all drink that may be drunk in every such vessel shall be unclean.

Lev 11:33


And every earthen vessel, whereinto any of them falleth, whatsoever is in it shall be unclean; and ye shall break it.

Lev 11:35

And every thing whereupon any part of their carcase falleth shall be unclean; whether it be oven, or ranges for pots, they shall be broken down: for they are unclean, and shall be unclean unto you.

Lev 11:36

Nevertheless a fountain or pit, wherein there is plenty of water, shall be clean: but that which toucheth their carcase shall be unclean.



Lev 11:37

And if any part of their carcase fall upon any sowing seed which is to be sown, it shall be clean.

Lev 11:38

But if any water be put upon the seed, and any part of their carcase fall thereon, it shall be unclean unto you.

Lev 11:41

And every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth shall be an abomination; it shall not be eaten.

Lev 11:42

Whatsoever goeth upon the belly, and whatsoever goeth upon all four, or whatsoever hath more feet among all creeping things that creep upon the earth, them ye shall not eat; for they are an abomination.

Lev 11:43

Ye shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creepeth, neither shall ye make yourselves unclean with them, that ye should be defiled thereby.

Lev 11:44

For I am the Ahayah your Alahayim: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
