

Is Reincarnation True?

Reincarnation: the rebirth of a soul in another body

Job 14:10,12,14

[10]But man dieth, and wasteth away: yea, man giveth up the ghost, and where is he? [12]So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens be no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.

[14] If a man die, shall he live again? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.

1 Corinthians 15:51-53

[51]Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, [52]In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. [53]For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

II Baruch 51

51 1 And it shall come to pass, when that appointed day has gone by, that then shall the aspect of those who are condemned be afterwards changed, and the glory of those who are justified. 2 For the aspect of those who now act wickedly shall become worse than it is, as they shall suffer torment. 3 Also (as for) the glory of those who have now been justified in My law, who have had understanding in their life, and who have planted in their heart the root of wisdom, then their splendor shall be glorified in changes, and the form of their face shall be turned into the light of their beauty, that they may be able to acquire and receive the world which does not die, which is then promised to them. 4 For over this above all shall those who come then lament, that they rejected My law, and stopped their ears that they might not hear wisdom or receive understanding. 5 When therefore they see those, over whom they are now exalted, (but) who shall then be exalted and glorified more than they, they shall respectively be transformed, the latter into the splendor of angels, and the former shall yet more waste away in wonder at the visions and in the beholding of the forms. 6 For they shall first behold and afterwards depart to be tormented.

Wisdom of Solomon 15:11

[11] Forasmuch as he knew not his Maker, and him that inspired into him an active soul, and breathed in a living spirit.



Wisdom of Solomon 15:16-17

[16] For man made them, and he that borrowed his own spirit fashioned them: but no man can make a alahayim like unto himself.

[17] For being mortal, he worketh a dead thing with wicked hands: for he himself is better than the things which he worshippeth: whereas he lived once, but they never.

Wisdom of Solomon 7:6

[6] For all men have one entrance into life, and the like going out.

Hebrews 9:27

[27] And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Wisdom of Solomon 16:13

[13] For thou hast power of life and death: thou leadest to the gates of hell, and bringest up again.

[14]A man indeed killeth through his malice: and the spirit, when it is gone forth, returneth not; neither the soul received up cometh again.

II Baruch 23

3 For as you have not forgotten the people who now are and those who have passed away, so I remember those who are appointed to come. 4 Because when Adam sinned and death was decreed against those who should be born, then the multitude of those who should be born was numbered, and for that number a place was prepared where the living might dwell and the dead might be guarded. Before therefore the number aforesaid is fulfilled, the creature will not live again [for My spirit is the creator of life], and Sheol will receive the dead.

1 Thessalonians 4:15-17

[15] For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

[16] For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Alahayim: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: [17] Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Job 19:25-27

[25] For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

[26]And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see Alahayim:



[27] Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.

Revelation 20:4-6

- [4] And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Yashe, and for the word of Alahayim, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.
- [5] But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.
- [6] Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of Alahayim and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Apocalypse of Paul 14

14. I indeed when I had heard this sighed and wept, and said to the angel: I wished to see the souls of the just and of sinners, and to see in what manner they go out of the body. And the angel answered and said unto me: Look again upon the earth. And I looked and saw all the world, and men were as naught and a-wanting: and I looked carefully and saw a certain man about to die, and the angel said to me: This one whom thou seest is a just man. And I looked again and saw all his works whatever he had done for the sake of Alahayim's name, and all his desires, both what he remembered, and what he did not remember; they all stood in his sight in the hour of need; and I saw the just man advance and find refreshment and confidence, and before he went out of the world the holy and the impious angels both attended: and I saw them all, but the impious found no place of habitation in him, but the holy took possession of his soul, guiding it till it went out of the body: and they roused the soul saying: "Soul, know thy body whence thou goest out, for it is necessary that thou shouldst return to the same body on the day of the resurrection, that thou mayest receive the things promised to all the just.

Apocalypse of paul 15

15. And he saith to me: Look again down on the earth, and watch the soul of an impious man going out of the body, which vexed AHAYAH day and night, saying: "I know nothing else in this world, I eat and drink, and enjoy what is in the world; for who is there who has descended into hell, and ascending has declared to us that there is judgment there!"



Apocalypse of Paul 15

And again I looked carefully and saw all the scorn of the sinner, and all that he did, and they stood together before him in the hour of need: and it was done to him in that hour, in which he was threatened about his body at the judgment, and he said: "It were better for me if I had not been born." And after these things, there came at the same time, the holy angels, and the malign, and the soul of the sinner and the holy angels did not find a place in it. Moreover the malign angels cursed it; and when they had drawn it out of the body, the angels admonished it a third time, saying: "O wretched soul, look upon thy flesh, whence thou camest out: for it is necessary that thou shouldst return to thy flesh in the day of resurrection, that thou mayest receive the due for thy sins and thy impieties.
