

Binding the Law upon thy Hands

Deu 6:1

Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which Ahayah your Alahayim commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it:

Deu 6:7

And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Deu 6:8

And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.

H7194 (Strong)

ַק*ָ*שַׁר

A primitive root; to *tie*, physically (*gird*, *confine*, *compact*) or mentally (in *love*, *league*): - bind (up), (make a) conspire (-acy, -ator), join together, knit, stronger, work [treason].

Exo 13:9

And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that Ahayah's law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath Ahayah brought thee out of Egypt.

Deu 11:18

Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.

Deu 6:9

And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.



Num 15:38

Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue:

Num 15:39 And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of Ahayah, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:

Num 15:40 That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your Alahayim.
