Men's Garments

Deuteronomy 22:5

[5]The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's

garment: for all that do so are abomination unto Ahayah thy Alahayim.

Romans 14:13

13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.

Laws on Jewelry

Jas 2:2



For if there come unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in goodly apparel, and there come in also a poor man in vile raiment;

Laws on Tattoos

Tattoos are against the law, as it is written "Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks H7085 upon you." Lev 19:28.

BDB Definition: incision, imprintment, tattoo, mark.

Strong's Definition: From the same as 6970; an incision or gash:— + mark.



Appearance of the Heads

Lev 19:27

Ye shall not round H5362 the corners H6285 of your heads,

Definition:

H5362

נַקף

A primitive root; to strike with more or less violence (beat, fell, corrode); by implication (of attack) to knock together, that is, <u>surround or circulate</u>: - compass (about, -ing), <u>cut down, destroy</u>, go round (about), inclose, round.

H6285

פאה

Feminine of H6311; properly mouth in a figurative sense, that is, direction, region, extremity: - corner, end, quarter, side.

Judges 16:13

And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven **locks H4253** of my head with the web.

Definition:

H4253

מחלפה

from H2498; braid, lock, plait, a ringlet of hair (as gliding over each other):—lock.

Numbers 6:5

All the days of the vow of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth himself unto Ahayah, he shall be holy, and shall let **the locks H6545** of the hair of his head grow.

Definition:



H6545

פרע

from 6544; the hair (as dishevelled), long hair (of head):—locks.

3. Bald heads.

Jasher 54:107

[107] And Jacob rose up and put on the garments which Joseph had sent him, and after he had washed, and shaved his hair, he put upon his head the turban which Joseph had sent him.

shave: (of a man) cut the hair with a razor; an act of shaving hair from the face or part of the body.

II Sam 14:26

[26] And when he polled H1548 his head, (for it was at every year's end that he polled it: because the hair was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:) he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

Definition:

H1548

גלח

A primitive root; properly <u>to be bald</u>, that is, (causatively) to shave; figuratively to lay waste: - poll, shave (off)

baldness: - bald (-ness), X utterly

The laws for the Priest's head grooming.

Lev 21:1

And AHAYAH said unto Moses, Speak unto the priests the sons of Aaron, and say unto them, ...:

Lev 21:5



They shall not make baldness upon their head,

Ezekiel 44:20

Neither shall they shave their heads, nor suffer their locks H6545 to grow long; they shall only poll H3697 their heads.

Definition:

H6545

from 6544; the hair (as dishevelled), long hair (of head):—locks.

H3697

כסם

A primitive root; to shear: - X only, poll

poll: to clip; to cut off the ends; to cut off hair or wool; to shear; to mow; to crop.

Edification on Mustaches.

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H2206

זקן

BDB Definition: from 2204; the beard, chin. **Strong's**: beard (as indicating age):—beard.

H8222

BDB Definition: from 8193; moustache. **Strong's**: the beard (as a lip-piece):— beard, (upper) lip.

Edification on Beards

2 Samuel 19:24

24 And Mephibosheth the son of Saul came down to meet the king, and had neither dressed his feet, nor <u>trimmed</u> his beard,H8222 nor washed his clothes, from the day the king departed until the day he came again in peace.

The laws concerning Beards

Leviticus 19:27

Ye shall not round the corners of your heads, neither shalt thou mar (H7843) the corners of thy beard.

Definitions:

H7843

שחת

Original Strong's Definition: A primitive root; to decay, that is, (causatively) <u>ruin</u> (literally or figuratively): - batter, cast off, corrupt (-er, thing), <u>destroy</u> (-er, -uction), lose, mar, perish, spill, spoiler, X utterly, waste (-r).

Lev 21:5

They shall not make baldness upon their head, neither shall they **shave off H1548** the corner of their beard, nor make any cuttings in their flesh

Definition:

H1548

גלח

A primitive root; properly <u>to be bald</u>, that is, (causatively) to shave; figuratively to lay waste: - poll, shave (off).



The laws for the Children of Ahayah

Deuteronomy 14:1

Ye are the children of Ahayah your Alahayim: ye shall not cut yourselves, **nor make** any baldness H7144 between your eyes for the dead.

Definition:

H7144

קְרְחָא קּרְחָה From H7139;

From H7139; baldness: - bald (-ness), X utterly.

2Ch 33:8

Neither will I any more remove the foot of Israel from out of the land which I have appointed for your fathers; so that they will take heed to do all that I have commanded them, according to the whole law and the statutes and the ordinances by the hand of Moses.

Mal 4:4

Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments.

Is he the Alahayim of the Jews only? is he not also of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also:

Do we then make void the law through faith? Alahayim forbid: yea, we establish the law.

Deu 6:25

And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before Ahayah our Alahayim, as he hath commanded us.

Gad the seer chapter 2

12.for everyone will join you in the covenant in the Law, testimonies, statutes, and ordinances.
