



# Signs to identify the Scattered Israelites: Pt. 3

## The Curses Upon the Hebrews:

Deu 28:45

Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of Ahayah thy Alahayim, to keep his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee:

Deu 28:46

And they shall be upon thee for a sign and for a wonder, and upon thy seed for ever.

Deu 28:47

Because thou servedst not Ahayah thy Alahayim with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all *things*;

Bar 1:19

Since the day that Ahayah brought our forefathers out of the land of Egypt, unto this present day, we have been disobedient unto Ahayah our Alahayim, and we have been negligent in not hearing his voice.

Bar 1:20

Wherefore the evils cleaved unto us, and the curse, which Ahayah appointed by Moses his servant at the time that he brought our fathers out of the land of Egypt, to give us a land that floweth with milk and honey, like as it is to see this day.

Bar 1:21

Nevertheless we have not hearkened unto the voice of Ahayah our Alahayim, according unto all the words of the prophets, whom he sent unto us:

Bar 1:22

But every man followed the imagination of his own wicked heart, to serve strange alahayims, and to do evil in the sight of Ahayah our Alahayim.

Bar 2:1



Therefore Ahayah hath made good his word, which he pronounced against us, and against our judges that judged Israel, and against our kings, and against our princes, and against the men of Israel and Juda,

Bar 2:2

To bring upon us great plagues, such as never happened under the whole heaven, as it came to pass in Jerusalem, according to the things that were written in the law of Moses;

Bar 2:3

That a man should eat the flesh of his own son, and the flesh of his own daughter.

Bar 2:4

Moreover he hath delivered them to be in subjection to all the kingdoms that are round about us, to be as a reproach and desolation among all the people round about, where Ahayah hath scattered them.

Bar 2:5

Thus we were cast down, and not exalted, because we have sinned against Ahayah our Alahayim, and have not been obedient unto his voice.

Bar 2:6

To Ahayah our Alahayim appertaineth righteousness: but unto us and to our fathers open shame, as appeareth this day.

Bar 2:7

For all these plagues are come upon us, which Ahayah hath pronounced against us

Bar 2:8

Yet have we not prayed before Ahayah, that we might turn every one from the imaginations of his wicked heart.

Bar 2:9

Wherefore Ahayah watched over us for evil, and Ahayah hath brought it upon us: for Ahayah is righteous in all his works which he hath commanded us.

Deu 28:15

But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of Ahayah thy Alahayim, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Deu 28:16

Cursed *shalt* thou *be* in the city, and cursed *shalt* thou *be* in the field.

Deu 28:17



Cursed *shall be* thy basket and thy store.

Deu 28:18

Cursed *shall be* the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy land, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

Acts of Thomas

12 “Remember, my children, what my brother said to you, and to whom he commended you; and know that if you refrain from this filthy intercourse you become temples holy and pure, being released from afflictions and troubles, known and unknown, and you will not be involved in the cares of life and of children, whose end is destruction. But if you get many children, for their sakes you become grasping and avaricious, plundering orphans and deceiving widows, and by doing this you subject yourselves to most grievous punishments. For most children become unprofitable, being possessed by demons, some openly and some secretly. For they become either lunatics or half-withered or crippled or deaf or dumb or paralytics or idiots. And though they be healthy, they will be again good-for-nothing, doing unprofitable and abominable works. For they will be detected either in adultery or in murder or in theft or in unchastity, and by all these you will be afflicted. But if you obey and preserve your souls pure to Alahayim, there will be born to you living children, untouched by these hurtful things, and you will be without care, spending an untroubled life, free from grief and care, looking forward to receive that incorruptible and true marriage, and you will enter as groomsmen into that bridal chamber full of immortality and light.”

Deu 28:19

Cursed *shalt thou be* when thou comest in, and cursed *shalt thou be* when thou goest out.

Deu 28:20


Ahayah shall send upon thee cursing, vexation, and rebuke, in all that thou settest thine hand unto for to do, until thou be destroyed, and until thou perish quickly; because of the wickedness of thy doings, whereby thou hast forsaken me.

Deu 28:21

Ahayah shall make the pestilence cleave unto thee, until he have consumed thee from off the land, whither thou goest to possess it.

Deu 28:22

Ahayah shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a fever, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and



with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou perish.

Deu 28:23

And thy heaven that is over thy head shall be brass, and the earth that is under thee shall be iron.

Deu 28:24

Ahayah shall make the rain of thy land powder and dust: from heaven shall it come down upon thee, until thou be destroyed.


Deu 28:25

Ahayah shall cause thee to be smitten before thine enemies: thou shalt go out one way against them, and flee seven ways before them: and shalt be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.

Enoch 89: 54-61

54. And after that I saw that when they forsook the house of AHAYAH and His tower they fell away entirely, and their eyes were blinded; and I saw the Adono of the sheep how He wrought much slaughter amongst them in their herds until those sheep invited that slaughter and betrayed His place. 55. And He gave them over into the hands of the lions and tigers, and wolves and hyenas, and into the hand of the foxes, and to all the wild beasts, and those wild beasts began to tear in pieces those sheep. 56. And I saw that He forsook that their house and their tower and gave them all into the hand of the lions, to tear and devour them, into the hand of all the wild beasts. 57. And I began to cry aloud with all my power, and to appeal to the Adono of the sheep, and to represent to Him in regard to the sheep that they were devoured by all the wild beasts. 58. And every excess and the destruction which will be wrought through the shepherds, record (namely) how many they destroy according to my command, and how many according to their own caprice: record against every individual shepherd all the destruction he effects.

Ahayah shall smite thee with madness, and blindness, and astonishment of heart:

And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save *thee*.

Deu 28:30

Thou shalt betroth a wife, and another man shall lie with her: thou shalt build an house, and thou shalt not dwell therein: thou shalt plant a vineyard, and shalt not gather the grapes thereof.

Deu 28:31

Thine ox *shall be* slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass *shall be* violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep *shall be* given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue *them*.

Deu 28:32

Thy sons and thy daughters *shall be* given unto another people, and thine eyes shall look, and fail *with longing* for them all the day long: and *there shall be* no might in thine hand.

Deu 28:33

The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up;



and thou shalt be only oppressed and crushed alway:

Deu 28:34

So that thou shalt be mad for the sight of thine eyes which thou shalt see.

Deu 28:35

Ahayah shall smite thee in the knees, and in the legs, with a sore botch that cannot be healed, from the sole of thy foot unto the top of thy head.

Deu 28:36

Ahayah shall bring thee, and thy king which thou shalt set over thee, unto a nation which neither thou nor thy fathers have known; and there shalt thou serve other alahayims, wood and stone.

Deu 28:37

And thou shalt become an astonishment, a proverb, and a byword, among all nations whither Ahayah shall lead thee.

Psa 44:14

Thou makest us a byword among the heathen, a shaking of the head among the people.

Jas 1:1

James, a servant of Alahayim and of the Lord Yache Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

Jas 2:5

Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not Alahayim chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

Rev 2:9

I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and *I know* the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but *are* the synagogue of Satan.

Gad the seer 2:15,17-20,24-25

15. Woe to you, o Edom, that sits in the land of Kittim in the north of the sea.  
17 .For you have said: 'On high is my seat, and I have knowledge of the Alahayim of Alahayims, for AHAYAH chose me instead of His holy people, for He loathed them.  
18.And His former people, despised and rejected, did not know AHAYAH or His image.  
19. Verily we are wise and clever; we know AHAYAH and His Law, we know His image and presence.'



20. Therefore thus saith AHAYAH: 'Because you rose so high to talk about the Alahayim of Alahayim s, know that you shall perish in your cleverness.

24. O jealous AHAYAH, come out; come out of your place and thrash Edom; consume them.

25. Come to Zerephath, come to Sepharad, come to Ashkenaz, come to Garmania

Deu 28:38

Thou shalt carry much seed out into the field, and shalt gather *but* little in; for the locust shall consume it.

Deu 28:39

Thou shalt plant vineyards, and dress *them*, but shalt neither drink *of* the wine, nor gather *the grapes*; for the worms shall eat them.

Deu 28:40

Thou shalt have olive trees throughout all thy coasts, but thou shalt not anoint *thyself* with the oil; for thine olive shall cast *his fruit*.

Deu 28:41

Thou shalt beget sons and daughters, but thou shalt not enjoy them; for they shall go into captivity.

Deu 28:42

All thy trees and fruit of thy land shall the locust consume.

Deu 28:43

The stranger that *is* within thee shall get up above thee very high; and thou shalt come down very low.

Deu 28:44

He shall lend to thee, and thou shalt not lend to him: he shall be the head, and thou shalt be the tail.

Deu 28:45



Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which Ahayah shall send against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all *things*: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he have destroyed thee.

Deu 28:49

Ahayah shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, *as swift* as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

2Es 11:1;12:9

1 Then saw I a dream, and, behold, there came up from the sea an eagle, which had twelve feathered wings, and three heads.

2Es 12:9

For thou hast judged me worthy to shew me the last times.

2Es 6:9

For Esau is the end of the world, and Jacob is the beginning of it that followeth

Dan 8:23

And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.

2Es 12:11

The eagle, whom thou sawest come up from the sea, is the kingdom which was seen in the vision of thy brother Daniel.

Jasher 10:16


16. And the children of Chittim are the Romim who dwell in the valley of Canopia by the river Tibreu.

Oba 1:1

The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith Adonye Ahayah concerning Edom; We have heard a



rumour from Ahayah, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

Oba 1:4

Though thou exalt *thyself* as the eagle, and though thou set thy nest among the stars, thence will I bring thee down, saith Ahayah.

Psa 137:7

Remember, O Ahayah, the children of Edom in the day of Jerusalem; who said, Rase *it*, rase *it, even* to the foundation thereof.

Psa 137:8

O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy *shall he be*, that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us.

Deu 28:50

A nation of fierce countenance, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor shew favour to the young:

Jubilee 19:13-14

13. And in the forty third Jubilee, in the second week, in the third year thereof, [2110 A.M.] Rebecca bare to Isaac two sons, Jacob and Esau, and Jacob was a smooth and upright man, and Esau was fierce, a man of the field, and hairy, and Jacob dwelt in tents. 14. And the youths grew, and Jacob learned to write; but Esau did not learn, for he was a man of the field and a hunter, and he learnt war, and all his deeds were fierce.

Amo 1:11

Thus saith Ahayah; For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away *the punishment* thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever:


Eze 35:12

And thou shalt know that I *am* Ahayah, *and that* I have heard all thy blasphemies which thou hast spoken against the mountains of Israel, saying, They are laid desolate, they are given us to consume.

Eze 35:10

Because thou hast said, These two nations and these two countries shall be mine, and we will possess it; whereas Ahayah was there:

Eze 25:12

Thus saith Adonoye Ahayah; Because that Edom hath dealt against the house of Judah by taking vengeance, and hath greatly offended, and revenged himself upon them;

Rom 12:19

Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but *rather* give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance *is* mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

Rom 12:20

Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

Rom 12:21

Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

Gen 25:24

And when her days to be delivered were fulfilled, behold, *there were* twins in her womb.

Gen 25:25


And the first came out red, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau.

Gen 25:26

And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac *was* threescore years old when she bare them.

Jubilee 36:9-11

9. And if either of you deviseth evil against his brother, know that from henceforth every one that deviseth evil against his brother will fall into his hand, and will be rooted out of the land of the living, and his seed will be destroyed from under heaven. 10. But on the day of turbulence and execration and indignation and anger, with flaming devouring fire as He burnt Sodom, so likewise will He burn his land and his city and all that is his, and he will be blotted out of the book of the discipline of the children of men, and not be recorded in the book of life, but in that which is appointed to destruction, and he will depart into eternal execration; so that their condemnation may be always renewed in hate and in execration and in wrath and in torment and in indignation and in plagues and in disease for ever. 11. I say and testify to you, my sons, according to the judgment which will come upon the man who wisheth to injure his brother."



Deu 10:18

He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

Deu 10:19

Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Deu 28:51

And he shall eat the fruit of thy cattle, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which *also* shall not leave thee *either* corn, wine, or oil, *or* the increase of thy kine, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

Deu 28:52

And he shall besiege thee in all thy gates, until thy high and fenced walls come down, wherein thou trustedst, throughout all thy land: and he shall besiege thee in all thy gates throughout all thy land, which Ahayah thy Alahayim hath given thee.

Deu 28:53

And thou shalt eat the fruit of thine own body, the flesh of thy sons and of thy daughters, which Ahayah thy Alahayim hath given thee, in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee:

Deu 28:54

*So that* the man *that is* tender among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

Deu 28:55 *So that* he will not give to any of them of the flesh of his children whom he shall eat: because he hath nothing left him in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee in all thy gates.

Deu 28:56 The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

Deu 28:57

And toward her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: for she shall eat them for want of all *things* secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.

Deu 28:58

If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, AHAYAH THY Ahayah;



Deu 28:59

Then Ahayah will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, *even* great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance.

Deu 28:60

Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee.

Deu 28:61 Also every sickness, and every plague, which is not written in the book of this law, them will Ahayah bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed.

Deu 28:62

And ye shall be left few in number, whereas ye were as the stars of heaven for multitude; because thou wouldest not obey the voice of Ahayah thy Alahayim.

Deu 28:63

And it shall come to pass, *that* as Ahayah rejoiced over you to do you good, and to multiply you; so Ahayah will rejoice over you to destroy you, and to bring you to nought; and ye shall be plucked from off the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Deu 28:64

And Ahayah shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other alahayims, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, *even* wood and stone.

Deu 28:65

And among these nations shalt thou find no ease, neither shall the sole of thy foot have rest: but Ahayah shall give thee there a trembling heart, and failing of eyes, and sorrow of mind:

Deu 28:66

And thy life shall hang in doubt before thee; and thou shalt fear day and night, and shalt have none assurance of thy life:

Deu 28:67

In the morning thou shalt say, Would Alahayim it were even! and at even thou shalt say, Would Alahayim it were morning! for the fear of thine heart wherewith thou shalt fear, and for the sight of thine eyes which thou shalt see.

Deu 28:68

And Ahayah shall bring thee into Egypt again with ships, by the way whereof I spake unto thee, Thou shalt see it no more again: and there ye shall be sold unto your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen, and no man shall buy *you*.
