



# The Children of the Covenant

Mal 3:6

For I *am* Ahayah, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Psa 105:6

O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen

Isa 41:8

But thou, Israel, *art* my servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend

Psa 102:27

But thou *art* the same, and thy years shall have no end.

Psa 102:28 The children of thy servants shall continue, and their seed shall be established before thee.

Tob 13:9

O Jerusalem, the holy city, he will scourge thee for thy children's works, and will have mercy again on the sons of the righteous.

Ecclesiasticus 44:1

Let us now praise famous men, and our fathers that begat us.

Ecclesiasticus 44:2

The Lord hath wrought great glory by them through his great power from the beginning.

Ecclesiasticus 44:3

Such as did bear rule in their kingdoms, men renowned for their power, giving counsel by their understanding, and declaring prophecies:

Ecclesiasticus 44:4 Leaders of the people by their counsels, and by their knowledge of learning meet for the people, wise and eloquent are their instructions:

Ecclesiasticus 44:5 Such as found out musical tunes, and recited verses in writing:

Ecclesiasticus 44:6 Rich men furnished with ability, living peaceably in their habitations:



Ecclesiasticus 44:7 All these were honoured in their generations, and were the glory of their times.

Ecclesiasticus 44:8 There be of them, that have left a name behind them, that their praises might be reported.

Ecclesiasticus 44:10 But these were merciful men, whose righteousness hath not been forgotten.

Ecclesiasticus 44:11 With their seed shall continually remain a good inheritance, and their children are within the covenant.

Ecclesiasticus 44:12 Their seed standeth fast, and their children for their sakes.

Ecclesiasticus 44:13 Their seed shall remain for ever, and their glory shall not be blotted out.

Psa 22:30

A seed shall serve him; it shall be accounted to the Lord for a generation.

Psa 22:31

They shall come, and shall declare his righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that he hath done *this*.

Deuteronomy 23:7

Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he is thy brother: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

Deuteronomy 23:8

The children that are begotten of them shall enter into the congregation of Ahayah in their third generation.

Amos 9:11

In that day will I raise up the tabernacle of David that is fallen, and close up the breaches thereof; and I will raise up his ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old:

Amos 9:12 That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my name, saith Ahayah that doeth this.

Exodus 23:9

Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.



1 Corinthians 7:20

Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.

1 Corinthians 7:21 Art thou called being a servant? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use it rather.

1 Corinthians 7:22 For he that is called in the Lord, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, being free, is Christ's servant.

1 Corinthians 7:23 Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.

1 Corinthians 7:24 Brethren, let every man, wherein he is called, therein abide with Alahayim.

Ephesians 6:7

With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men:

Ephesians 6:8 Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free.

Colossians 4:1

Masters, give unto your servants that which is just and equal; knowing that ye also have a Master in heaven.

Rom 9:24

Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

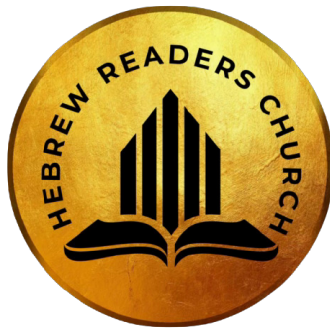
Rom 9:25 As he saith also in Osee, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved.

Rom 9:26 And it shall come to pass, *that* in the place where it was said unto them, Ye *are* not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living Alahayim.

Isaiah 19:21

And Ahayah shall be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians shall know Ahayah in that day, and shall do sacrifice and oblation; yea, they shall vow a vow unto Ahayah, and perform it.

Isaiah 19:22 And Ahayah shall smite Egypt: he shall smite and heal it: and they shall return even to Ahayah, and he shall be intreated of them, and shall heal them.



Isaiah 19:23 In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

Isaiah 19:24 In that day shall Israel be the third with Egypt and with Assyria, even a blessing in the midst of the land:

Isaiah 19:25 Whom Ahayah of hosts shall bless, saying, Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel mine inheritance.

Isaiah 14:1

For Ahayah will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

Isaiah 14:2

And the people shall take them, and bring them to their place: and the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of Ahayah for servants and handmaids: and they shall take them captives, whose captives they were; and they shall rule over their oppressors.

2 Baruch 72

2 After the signs have come, of which you were told before, when the nations become turbulent, and the time of My Messiah is come, he shall both summon all the nations, and some of them he shall spare, and some of them he shall slay. 3 These things therefore shall come upon the nations which are to be spared by Him. 4 Every nation, which knows not Israel and has not trodden down the seed of Jacob, shall indeed be spared. 5 And this because some out of every nation shall be subjected to thy people. 6 But all those who have ruled over you, or have known you, shall be given up to the sword.

74:1 And it shall come to pass in those days that the reapers shall not grow weary, nor those that build be toil-worn; For the works shall of themselves speedily advance Together with those who do them in much tranquility.

73:2

And then healing shall descend in dew, and disease shall withdraw, and anxiety and anguish and lamentation pass from amongst men, and gladness proceed through the whole earth. 3 And no one shall again die untimely, nor shall any adversity suddenly befall. 4 And judgments, and abusive talk, and contentions, and revenges, and blood, and passions, and envy, and hatred, and whatsoever things are like these shall go into condemnation when they are removed.
