

The Land for Israel in Christ Pt.II

Jeremiah 23:1 Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith Ahayah.

Jeremiah 23:2 Therefore thus saith Ahayah Alahayim of Israel against the pastors that feed my people; Ye have scattered my flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith Ahayah.

Jeremiah 23:3 And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.

Jeremiah 23:4 And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith Ahayah.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10:14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

Romans 10:15 And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

Isaiah 30:20 And though the Lord give you the bread of adversity, and the water of affliction, yet shall not thy teachers be removed into a corner any more, but thine eyes shall see thy teachers:

Isaiah 30:21 And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Isaiah 30:22 Ye shall defile also the covering of thy graven images of silver, and the ornament of thy molten images of gold: thou shalt cast them away as a menstruous cloth; thou shalt say unto it, Get thee hence.

Jeremiah 23:5 Behold, the days come, saith Ahayah, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.



Jeremiah 23:6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, AHAYAH OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Jeremiah 23:7 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith Ahayah, that they shall no more say, Ahayah liveth, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;

Isaiah 1:18

Come now, and let us reason together, saith Ahayah: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. Isaiah 1:10

If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:

H₁₄ (Strong)

אבה

A primitive root; to *breathe* after, that is (figuratively) to *be acquiescent:* - consent, rest content, will, be willing.

H8085 (Strong)

שמע

A primitive root; to *hear* intelligently (often with implication of attention, obedience, etc.; causatively to *tell*, etc.): - X attentively, call (gather) together, X carefully, X certainly, consent, consider, be content, declare, X diligently, discern, give ear, (cause to, let, make to) hear (-ken, tell), X indeed, listen, make (a) noise, (be) obedient, obey, perceive, (make a) proclaim (-ation), publish, regard, report, shew (forth), (make a) sound, X surely, tell, understand, whosoever [heareth], witness.

Isaiah 1:20

But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of Ahayah hath spoken it.

2 Esdras 7:25
