



Yache Our Example

John 13:13

Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

John 13:14

If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

John 13:15

For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

John 13:16

Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.

John 13:17

If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.

Testament of Judah 23:1-3

23 1 And after these things shall a star arise to you from Jacob in peace, And a man shall arise [from my seed], like the sun of righteousness, walking with the sons of men in meekness and righteousness; And no sin shall be found in him. 2 and the heavens shall be open unto him, To pour out the spirit, (even) the blessing of the Holy Father; 3 And He shall pour out the spirit of grace upon you; And ye shall be

Psalms 45:2

Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore Alahayim hath blessed thee for ever.

Psalms 45:4



And in thy majesty ride prosperously because of truth and meekness and righteousness; and thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things.

That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

Ephesians 4:23

And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

Ephesians 4:24

And that ye put on the new man, which after Alahayim is created in righteousness and true holiness.

1 John 2:3

And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

1 John 2:4

He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

1 John 2:5



But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of Alahayim perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.
