1Jn 5:3

For this is the love of Alahayim, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

- **Grievous**- weighty, that is, (figuratively) burdensome, grave: - grievous, heavy, weightier.

Matthew 11:29-30

Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Ecclesiasticus 6:20

She is very unpleasant to the unlearned: he that is without understanding will not remain with her.

Ecclesiasticus 15:8

For she is far from pride, and men that are liars cannot remember her.

2 But from wickedness flee away, destroying the (evil) inclination by your good works; for they that are double-faced serve not Alahayim, but their own lusts, so that they may please Beliar and men like unto themselves

1 But do not ye, my children, wear two faces like unto them, of goodness and of wickedness; but cleave unto goodness only, for Alahayim hath his habitation therein, and men desire it.

Lev 26:40

If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me;

Lev 26:41 And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:

Lev 26:42 Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.



Deu 4:30-31

When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to Ahayah thy Alahayim, and shalt be obedient unto his voice; 31 (For Ahayah thy Alahayim is a merciful Ala;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

2Co 13:4

For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of Alahayim. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of Alahayim toward you.

3[7]:3 Blessed are all they that work righteousness. They shall never be destroyed.

But we see Yache, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of Alahayim should taste death for every man.

Hebrews 2:10 For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

Hebrews 2:11 For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

Hebrews 2:12 Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.

Hebrews 2:13 And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

1 John 1:9

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.



Psalm 32:5

5 I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto Ahayah; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.

Ezk 18:27

Again, when the wicked man turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive.

Ezk 18:28 Because he considereth, and turneth away from all his transgressions that he hath committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Ezk 18:21 But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Ezk 18:22 All his transgressions that he hath committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he hath done he shall live.

Ezk 18:23 Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord Ahayah: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?

Ezk 33:14 Again, when I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; if he turn from his sin, and do that which is lawful and right;

Ezk 33:15 If the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statutes of life, without committing iniquity; he shall surely live, he shall not die.

Ezk 33:16

None of his sins that he hath committed shall be mentioned unto him: he hath done that which is lawful and right; he shall surely live.

Ezk 18:24

But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, *and* doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked *man* doeth, shall he live?

All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die.

Ezk 18:25 Yet ye say, The way of the Lord is not equal. Hear now, O house of Israel; Is not my way equal? are not your ways unequal?

Ezk 18:26 When a righteous man turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and dieth in them; for his iniquity that he hath done shall he die.

Ezk 18:27 Again, when the wicked man turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive.

 - Using self-observation to improve performance in personal or professional situations.
