



# Feast of trumpets

Leviticus 23:1-3

1 And AHAYAH spake unto Moses, saying,

Leviticus 23:2

Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of AHAYAH, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.

Leviticus 23:3

Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work therein: it is the sabbath of AHAYAH in all your dwellings.

- Remember in these feasts we are celebrating with Angels

Jubilees 2:17-18, 30

17. And He gave us a great sign, the Sabbath day, that we should work six days, but keep Sabbath on the seventh day from all work. 18. And all the angels of the presence, and all the angels of sanctification, these two great classes-He hath hidden us to keep the Sabbath with Him in heaven and on earth.

30.....For that day is more holy and blessed than any jubilee day of the jubilees: on this we kept Sabbath in the heavens before it was made known to any flesh to keep Sabbath thereon on the earth

- Ahayah taught us of this these feasts when he brought his holy Law in Sinai:

Exodus 19:1, 10-11, 16

In the third month, when the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came they into the wilderness of Sinai.

Exodus 19:10

And AHAYAH said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes,

Exodus 19:11 And be ready against the third day: for the third day AHAYAH will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.

Exodus 19:16

And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled.

- How angels came blowing trumpets and that event is what we are celebrating today

Deuteronomy 33:2



And he said, The LORD came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir unto them; he shined forth from mount Paran, and he came with ten thousands of saints: from his right hand went a fiery law for them.

Exodus 19:17-19

And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with Alahayim; and they stood at the nether part of the mount.

Exodus 19:18 And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because AHAYAH descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

Exodus 19:19

And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and Alahayim answered him by a voice.

Leviticus 23:24

Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

Leviticus 23:25 Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto AHAYAH.

Gas the seer 14:1-3,5-7

1.And it came to pass on the first day of the seventh month, in the head of the year, in the four hundred and seventy eighth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the second year of Solomon's reign over Israel, AHAYAH's vision came unto me, and I was upon the Gihon.

2.And I raised my eyes and lo, the heavens were open like a book, and I saw the glory of AHAYAH, sitting on a lofty and exceedingly high throne.

5.And the appearance of the glory of AHAYAH was like the appearance of the rainbow, His covenant.

6.And the host of heaven were standing before Him on His right hand and on His left, and Satan was standing by them, but behind them.

7.And lo, a man dressed in linen brought before the glory of AHAYAH three books that were written about every man.

Ascension of Isaiah 9:19-23

19. And I said to him what I had asked him in the third heaven:

20. "Show me how everything which is done in that world is known here."

21. And while I was still speaking to him, behold one of the angels who were standing by, more glorious than that angel, who had brought me up from the world.



22. Showed me some books, [but not like the books of this world, and he opened them, and the books had writing in them, but not like the books of this world. And they were given to me, and I read them, and behold the deeds of the children of Israel were written there, their deeds which you know, my son

Josab. 23. And I said, "Truly, nothing which is done in this world is hidden in the seventh heaven."

- This helps understand the books had saw being read and the significance of getting it together because repentance has an end for the children of Israel as opposed to the Gentiles who have until the end:

Hermas vision 2

2[6]:5 For the Master swear by His own glory, as concerning His elect; that if, now that this day has been set as a limit, sin shall hereafter be committed, they shall not find salvation; for repentance for the righteous hath an end; the days of repentance are accomplished for all the saints; whereas for the Gentiles there is repentance until the last day.

- With this understanding, hopefully we be encouraged to focus on our walk. Let's finish seeing what transpires on the feast of trumpets:

Gad the seer 14:6-16

6. And the host of heaven were standing before Him on His right hand and on His left, and Satan was standing by them, but behind them.

7. And lo, a man dressed in linen brought before the glory of AHAYAH three books that were written about every man.

- We now know these are the deeds of Israel

8. And he read in the first one and it was found to have the just deeds of His people, and AHAYAH said: "These will live for ever."

9. And Satan said: "Who are these guilty people?" And the man dressed in linen cried to Satan like a ram's horn, saying "Keep silent, for this day is holy to our master."

- This confirms it was a holy day, the feast of trumpets being the head of the year in the seventh month:

10. And he read in the second book, and it was found to have inadvertent sins of His people, and AHAYAH said: "Put aside this book, but save it, until one third of the month elapses, to see what they will do."

- There is mercy for sins of ignorance as we are growing to overcome unbelief. He is waiting to see what we will do on the day of atonement, that's the part of this month he is referring to.

11. And he read in the third book, and it was found to have malicious deeds of His people.

- Presumptuous sin is different

12. And AHAYAH said to Satan "These are thy share; take them to do with them as it seemeth good to thee."



13. And Satan took those who acted maliciously and he went with them to a waste land to destroy them there.

14. And the man dressed in linen cried like a ram's horn, saying:

15. "Happy is the people that know the joyful shout, that walk, o AHAYAH, in the light of thy countenance."

16. And I heard the voice of the host of heaven dancing and saying "Master of Justice, AHAYAH of hosts, the whole heaven and earth is full of His glory."

- As you see it's a feast day up there and the angels dance too.
