



Yache The Name of Salvation

Proverbs 30:1

The words of Agur the son of Jakeh, even the prophecy: the man spake unto Ithiel, even unto Ithiel and Ucal,

Proverbs 30:2

Surely I am more brutish than any man, and have not the understanding of a man.

Proverbs 30:3

I neither learned wisdom, nor have the knowledge of the holy.

Proverbs 30:4

Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?

Philippians 2:9

Wherefore Alahayim also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Acts 4:10

Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Yache Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom Alahayim raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

G2424 (Thayer)

Ἰησοῦς

Iēsous

Thayer Definition:

Jesus = “Yah is salvation”

- 1) Jesus, the Son of Alahayim, the Saviour of mankind, Alahayim incarnate
- 2) Jesus Barabbas was the captive robber whom the Jews begged Pilate to release instead of Christ
- 3) Joshua was the famous captain of the Israelites, Moses’ successor (Act 7:45, Heb 4:8)
- 4) Jesus, son of Eliezer, one of the ancestors of Christ (Luk 3:29)
- 5) Jesus, surnamed Justus, a Jewish Christian, an associate with Paul in the preaching of the gospel (Col 4:11)

H3091 (Strong)

יהושוע יהושע

From H3068 and H3467; *Jah-saved*; *Jehoshea* (that is, Joshua), the Jewish leader: - Jehoshea, Jehoshuah, Joshua. Compare H1954, H3442.

H7768

שוע

A primitive root; properly to *be free*; but used only causatively and reflexively to *halloo* (for help, that is, *freedom* from some trouble): - cry (aloud, out), shout.

H3442 (Strong)

ישוע

For H3091; *he will save*; *Jeshua*, the name of two Israelites, also of a place in Palestine: - Jeshua.

BDB Definition:

Jeshua = “he is saved”

H3469

ישעי

From H3467; *saving*; *Jishi*, the name of four Israelites: - Ishi.

BDB Definition:

Ishi = “He saves me”



H3470 (Strong)

ישעיהו ישעיה

From H3467 and H3050; *Jah has saved; Jeshajah*, the name of seven Israelites: -
Isaiah, Jesaiah, Jeshaiah.

BDB Definition:

Isaiah or Jesaiah or Jeshaiah = “Jah has saved”

H3467 (Strong)

ישע

A primitive root; properly to *be open, wide or free*, that is, (by implication) to *be safe*; causatively to *free or succor*: - X at all, avenging, defend, deliver (-er), help, preserve, rescue, be safe, bring (having) salvation, save (-iour), get victory.

Matthew 1:21

And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name YACHE: for he shall save his people from their sins.
