Lev 11:1-3

And the Ahayah spake unto Moses and to Aaron, saying unto them,

Lev 11:2

Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, These are the beasts which ye shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth.

Lev 11:3

Whatsoever parteth the hoof, and is clovenfooted, and cheweth the cud, among the beasts, that shall ye eat.

Deuteronomy 14:4-6, 9

4 These are the beasts which ye shall eat: the ox, the sheep, and the goat,

5 The hart, and the roebuck, and the fallow deer, and the wild goat, and the pygarg, and the wild ox, and the chamois.

6 And every beast that parteth the hoof, and cleaveth the cleft into two claws, and cheweth the cud among the beasts, that ye shall eat.

Deuteronomy 14:9

9 These ye shall eat of all that are in the waters: all that have fins and scales shall ye eat:

## **Clean fowls**

Deuteronomy 14:11

11 Of all clean birds ye shall eat.

Testament of Levi 9:13

13 And of every clean beast and bird offer a sacrifice to THE LORD

Lev 1:14

And if the burnt sacrifice for his offering to the LORD be of fowls, then he shall bring his offering of turtledoves, or of young pigeons.

Genesis 1:20

[20]And Alahayim said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven

2 Esdras 6:47-48

[47]Upon the fifth day thou saidst unto the seventh part, where the waters were gathered that it

should bring forth living creatures, fowls and fishes: and so it came to pass.

[48]For the dumb water and without life brought forth living things at the commandment of Alahayim, that all people might praise thy wondrous works

Wisdom of Solomon 19:11-12

[11]But afterwards they saw a new generation of fowls, when, being led with their appetite, they asked delicate meats.

[12]For quails came up unto them from the sea for their contentment.

By orthographical variation from H7951 through the idea of sluggishness; the quail collectively (as slow in flight from its weight): - quails.

**Quail family:**

The Phasianidae are a family of heavy, ground-living birds, which includes pheasants, partridges, junglefowl, chickens, turkeys, Old World quail, and peafowl. The family includes many of the most popular gamebirds.

## Clean flying creeping insects

Leviticus 11:21-22

21 Yet these may ye eat of every flying creeping thing that goeth upon all four, which have legs above their feet, to leap withal upon the earth;

22 Even these of them ye may eat; the locust after his kind, and the bald locust after his kind, and the cricket after his kind, and the grasshopper after his kind.

Jasher 80:33-34

33. And AHAYAH sent and brought numerous locusts into Egypt, the Chasel, Salom Chargol, and Chagole, locusts each of its kind, which devoured all that the hail had left remaining. 34. Then the Egyptians rejoiced at the locusts, although they consumed the produce of the field, and they caught them in abundance and salted them for food


1Ti 4:4

And if any beast, of which ye may eat, die; he that toucheth the carcase thereof shall be unclean until the even.

Lev 11:40

And he that eateth of the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: he also that beareth the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even.

Lev 17:15

And every soul that eateth that which died *of itself*, or that which was torn *with beasts*, *whether it be* one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and

But if he wash *them* not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his iniquity.
