

How to Pray Pt. III

Mat 14:19

And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to *his* disciples, and the disciples to the multitude

John 11:41

41 Then they took away the stone *from the place* where the dead was laid. And Yache lifted up *his* eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

Tob 3:11

Then she prayed toward the window, and said, Blessed art thou, O Lord my Alahayim, and thine holy and glorious name is blessed and honourable for ever: let all thy works praise thee for ever

Tob 3:12

And now, O Lord, I set I mine eyes and my face toward thee

Dan 6:10

Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his Alahayim, as he did aforetime

Mat 6:6

But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

1Ti 2:8

I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting

Isaiah 1:15

15 And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood

Exo 34:8

And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped



Psa 95:6

O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before Ahayah our maker

2Ch 20:18

And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with *his* face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before Ahayah, worshipping Ahayah

1Es 8:72

So all they that were then moved at the word of the Lord Alahayim of Israel assembled unto me, whilst I mourned for the iniquity: but I sat still full of heaviness until the evening sacrifice.

1Es 8:73

Then rising up from the fast with my clothes and the holy garment rent, and bowing my knees, and stretching forth my hands unto the Lord

1Ki 8:22

And Solomon stood before the altar of Ahayah in the presence of all the congregation of Israel, and spread forth his hands toward heaven:

Luk 18:10

Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. Luk 18:13

And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as *his* eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, Alahayim be merciful to me a sinner. Luk 18:14

I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *rather* than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

2Ma 15:26

But Judas and his company encountered the enemies with invocation and prayer. 2Ma 15:27

So that fighting with their hands, and praying unto Alahayim with their hearts, they slew no less than thirty and five thousand men: for through the appearance of Alahayim they were greatly cheered



Mat 26:26

And as they were eating, Yache took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

Mat 26:27

And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, Drink ye all of it
