And declared to be the Son of Alahayim with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:

2. The Son is the cup, and the Father is he who was milked; and the Holy Spirit is she who milked him; 3. And after her astonishment had worn off, her womb was found as it was at first, before she had conceived. 10.
